On arrival in Milford Sound enjoy a scenic cruise on this world-famous fiord, dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen falls. The vessel provides excellent viewing opportunities and plenty of time to enjoy the waterfalls, rain forest, mountains and wildlife.

Today's adventure is on the Great Alpine Highway. This remarkable journey on the Arthur's Pass Road is the shortest and most spectacular route across to the East Coast. Travel through the foothills of the mighty Southern Alps and alongside spectacular braided rivers until the flat green farmlands of the Canterbury Plains heralds your arrival into Christchurch.

MONA VALE, with its homestead formerly known as **Karewa**, a public park in the Christchurch suburb of Fendalton. The homestead and gate house are both listed as heritage buildings with Heritage New Zealand (NZHPT). The fernery and the rose garden, and pavilion with the setting of the park along the Avon River, add to the attractiveness of the property. BRIDGE of REMEMBRANCE is one of two main war memorials in Christchurch, New Zealand.

It is dedicated to those who died in World War I.

If time permits, we will drive by CATHEDRAL SQUARE, CANTERBURY MUSEUM, HAGLEY PARK, VICTORIA SQUARE, NEW REGENT STREET, and CHRISTCHURCH TRANSITIONAL CATHEDRAL (the "CARDBOARD CATHEDRAL").


9:00a.m. Depart Rotorua for WAITOMO via Mamaku Ranges and tour the famous WAITOMO GLOW-WORM CAVES.
