GARDEN by the BAY: Admission includes entry to FLOWER DOME & CLOUD FOREST

SUPERTREE GROVE, come face to face with 12 of the Gardens' 18 Supertrees at the Supertree Grove. Rising up to 50 metres above ground, these iconic giants provide shade in the day and come alive with an exhilarating light and musical show at night (**Light Show at 7:45p.m. for 10-15 minutes**)

FLOWER DOME, the roof is fitted with specially selected glass that allows optimal light in for plants while minimizing solar heat, allowing the conservatory to be more efficiently cooled. Cooled conservatory holds the Guinness World Record for the largest glass greenhouse (**temperature inside is 73-77 degrees Fahrenheit**). CLOUD FOREST, home to one of the world's tallest indoor waterfalls and a lush mountain clad with plants from around the world (**temperature inside is 73-77 degrees Fahrenheit**).

OCBC SKYWAY, suspended between two Supertrees at 72 feet above ground, this 128meters(419 feet) long aerial walkway offers marvellous opportunities to capture that postcard-worthy shot of the Gardens' lush surrounds, set in the heart of downtown Marina Bay (**additional admission fee: \$14.00 per person**)

8:15p.m. After the GARDEN RHAPSODY LIGHT SHOW, return back to the hotel.

8:45p.m. Arrive back at HILTON SINGAPORE ORCHARD. (B)

Singapore City Tour – MARINA BAY SANDS HOTEL

9:00a.m. Bus departs for CITY TOUR of SINGAPORE.

Drive by around CIVIC DISTRICT, HISTORIC PARLIAMENT HOUSE & NATIONAL GALLERY, KAMPONG GELAM was once a place for the Muslim community in the 1800s and LITTLE INDIA. THIAN HOCK KENG TEMPLE, Singapore's oldest Chinese Temple in the heart of Chinatown. Some shopping time in CHINATOWN for souvenir gifts.



Merlion Statue & Marina Bay Sands Hotel

Visit MERLION PARK, a famous Singapore landmark and a major tourist attraction.

MERLION STATUE with a head of a lion and a body of a fish, this beloved symbol has inspired myriad works of art and poetry. The statue's head represents the city's original name of Singapura (lion city in Sanskrit).

1:00p.m. Buffet lunch at the famous FULLERTON HOTEL, this landmark hotel was built in 1928. In December 2015 as a National Monument, it was once home to Singapore's General Post Office, the Exchange, Chamber of Commerce, and the prestigious Singapore Club.

4:00p.m. Check in at the FAMOUS MARINA BAY SANDS HOTEL (**5 star hotel**) for 1 night stay.

After check-in, some leisure time to browse around the hotel property.

Dinner on your own, lots of restaurants and food court. Or try your luck at the Casino inside the hotel.

The Spectra light & water show at Marina Bay Sands, outdoor features a combination of lasers, water fountains, light projections, and orchestral soundtrack. Shows are typically 8pm & 9pm. (last for 15 minutes).

Hotel guests have free access to the SkyPark Observation Deck. (B, L)

9:10a.m. Check-out of the hotel.

9:30a.m. A visit to TEAMLAB SINGAPORE – Art Science Museum.

11:30a.m. Bus departs for CLARKE QUAY, one of Singapore's most treasured landmarks. It is a must visit in Singapore. Clarke Quay is a charming waterfront district, situated along the beautiful Singapore River.

12:00p.m. CLARKE QUAY BUMBOAT CRUISE, this leisurely boat ride promises a unique perspective of the city- state's rich history, stunning skyline, and vibrant culture.

Several are fed by an underground reservoir and are renowned for their mineral-rich spring water.

The water in Waku Pond is so clear and clean that in 1985, the Japan Ministry of the Environment ranked it among some of the nation's best spring water.

Take PIRATE BOAT CRUISE on Lake Ashi, enjoy the serene natural beauty of the crater. You can see the picturesque sight of Hakone such as the glimmering surface of Lake Ashi, the highest mountain in Japan, Mt. Fuji and the red torii (gate) floating above the lake all at one glance

4:00p.m. Arrive at TENSEIAN ODAWARA EKI BEKKAN HOTEL(4 star hotel) directly connected to Odawara Station.

After check-in, relax and enjoy the rest of the day.

Enjoy natural hot spring on the 10th floor and ashuyu"foot onsen" on the 14th floor.

The hotel is inside the MINAKA ODAWARA with its Edo atmosphere, which is divided into two towers, are home to a variety of food and beverage stores. The "Seisho Food Stadium" features a variety of popular local restaurants from the Odawara and Seisho areas.

Hakone Ropeway Owakudani Black Eggs Amazake Chaya's Uguisu Mochi

We will take HAKONE ROPEWAY from TOGENDAI to OWAKUDANI. It is the perfect place for enjoying Hakone's scenic view. On a clear day, majestic Mount Fuji is visible, and the steam rising from the volcanic "Jigokudani" at Owakudani down below gives the trip an added thrill.

At OWAKUDANI VALLEY, some shopping time and lunch on your own in Owakudani.

In Owakudani, "Kuro-tamago (black egg)", which is said to increase your life by seven years if you eat one, a specialty item that can only be purchased here.

It is boiled carefully in a hot spring pond, steamed and deliciously finished boiled egg with a special black shell.

In the store, they sell Black Iso Peanuts, Dried Sliced Persimmons, & etc.

MARUYAMA BUSSAN's HAKONE ZAIKU, the traditional woodwork art is unique to the Hakone region and is considered valuable.

Hot nabe lunch at HAKONE SEKISHO TABIMONOGATARI.

Last stop, before leaving Hakone is HAKONE AMAZAKE CHAYA, founded 400 years ago and is a relaxing place where visitors can rest. Their amazake (sweet rice wine) is made with a recipe that has remained unchanged since opening. The amazake is non-alcoholic, and has a gentle sweetness yet contains no sugar. Even babies can drink it! Their menu has also remained unchanged and includes dishes such as mochi (rice cakes) that are handmade every morning.

3:00p.m. Return back to TENSEIAN ODAWARA EKI BEKKAN HOTEL. The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)
