On arrival in Milford Sound enjoy a scenic cruise on this world-famous fiord, dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen falls. The vessel provides excellent viewing opportunities and plenty of time to enjoy the waterfalls, rain forest, mountains and wildlife.


We will be taking the Milford Mariner from the Milford Visitor Terminal to cruise the Milford Sound area to the Tasman Sea.

2:05p.m. Depart GREYMOUTH on a scenic train ride on the TRANZ-ALPINE TRAIN for CHRISTCHURCH. The Tranz-Alpine Train is one of the world's great train journeys covering 223 kilometers (139 miles) one-way. Open-air viewing platform: At one end of the train is a large open-air viewing platform, ideal for seeing and photographing the scenery, with no glass in between you and it. **Cafe-bar:** In the centre of the train is a counter selling tea, coffee, wine, beer, spirits, snacks & light microwaveable meals at reasonable prices. I can recommend a cream tea in the afternoon, and a glass of Montana Sauvignon Blanc! You take your food & drink back to your seat. **Bring cash if possible as cards are sometimes not accepted if the credit card machine is out of cellphone range.**

6:30p.m. Arrive at CHRISTCHURCH, the largest city in South Island of New Zealand. Our driver will be waiting for us at the train station.

Check-in at **FABLE HOTEL CHRISTCHURCH** for 2 nights stay. After check-in, evening is at your leisure. **(B)**

Nov 6th, Friday

Christchurch

6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.

8:30a.m. Depart for our Half day CHRISTCHURCH CITY TOUR.

8:45a.m. Our first stop will be at the INTERNATIONAL ANTARCTIC CENTRE, one of New Zealand's best tourist attraction. Experience amazing Antarctica without leaving Christchurch, among other attractions, there is an Antarctic snow storm room, an audiovisual display, and little blue penguins at the NZ Penguin Encounter.

11:00a.m. Depart the INTERNATIONAL ANTARCTIC CENTRE for Punting (gondola ride)

11:45a.m. Punting on the Avon River.

Then a leisure walk to MONA VALE GARDENS.

MONA VALE, with its homestead formerly known as **Karewa**, a public park in the Christchurch suburb of Fendalton. The homestead and gate house are both listed as heritage buildings with Heritage New Zealand (NZHPT). The fernery and the rose garden, and pavilion with the setting of the park along the Avon River, add to the attractiveness of the property.

BRIDGE of REMEMBRANCE is one of two main war memorials in Christchurch, New Zealand. It is dedicated to those who died in World War I.

If time permits, we will drive by CATHEDRAL SQUARE, CANTERBURY MUSEUM, HAGLEY PARK, VICTORIA SQUARE, NEW REGENT STREET, and CHRISTCHURCH TRANSITIONAL CATHEDRAL (the "CARDBOARD CATHEDRAL").

1:00p.m. Tour concludes at the hotel. The rest of day is at your leisure. **(B)**

Nov 7th , Saturday

Christchurch - Rotorua

6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.
8:00a.m. Check-out of the hotel.
8:30a.m. Transfer to CHRISTCHURCH AIRPORT.
9:00a.m. Arrive CHRISTCHURCH AIRPORT, upon arrival, check-in at AIR NEW ZEALAND.
After check-in, you will have some time to have a coffee or grab a snack.
11:10a.m. Depart on AIR NEW ZEALAND FLT. #5782 bound for ROTORUA, the “thermal city” which is known for the Maori history and unique ongoing thermal activity including bubbling mud pools, geysers and steam vent.
1:00p.m. Arrival at ROTORUA AIRPORT. You will need to pickup your luggage.
Transfer to our hotel, **NOVOTEL ROTORUA LAKESIDE** for 3 nights stay.



Recommended to bring warm jacket to the Maori Dinner Show.

5:25p.m. Transfer to TE PA TU, New Zealand's most award winning cultural attraction.
6:00p.m. Evening MAORI DINNER SHOW include:

- Traditional welcoming ceremony
- Enter Forest, welcome beverage, indigenous canape menu, interactive activities, cultural performance
- View the hangi meal being lifted
- Feasting on a traditional hangi buffet dinner and NZ desserts
- Water, tea, coffee, kawakawa tea (Maori native plant) included

10:15p.m. After dinner, return to hotel. (B, D)

Nov 8th , Sunday

Rotorua

12:00a.m. Depart for a tour of Rotorua.
Transfer to SKYLINE GONDOLA, buffet lunch at the STRATOSPHERE RESTAURANT.
