- 1:00p.m. We will have Makunouchi Bento Style lunch at YUBIDO, the restaurant/gift shop that is right cross the museum.
- 2:00p.m. Depart for AWAMORI FACTORY “CHUKO”, the only distillery in Okinawa that creates its unique jars.
- 2:30p.m. The factory visit has an English video of Okinawa Awamori and you will be given an opportunity to taste different samples of awamori and umeshu (plum wine).
- 4:30p.m. Return to Hotel Palm Royal Naha. The rest of the afternoon is at your leisure.
Nadine will take anyone who is interested in walking around the famous Heiwa Dori and Matsumoto Shoten for famous konbu, dried shaved Katsuo(bonito), dried Shitake(mushrooms), etc. (B , L)

You can leave the rest of your things in your room. No need to check-out.

Thursday, Jan 21st Naha – Ishigaki Island

No breakfast at the hotel. **You can go to Lawson to buy musubi or sandwich.**

- 5:45a.m. Transfer to Naha Domestic Airport for an interisland flight to Ishigaki.
- 6:15a.m. Check-in at Naha Airport at JAL. Be sure to check that you have your passport with you.
After check in procedures, you are free to roam around the airport or get something to eat.
- 7:15am Depart on Japan Trans Ocean Flt.#601 bound for Ishigaki.
- 8:15am Arrive at “ **Painushima Ishigaki Airport**” upon arrival, please use the restroom inside the baggage claim area before getting on to the bus.
- 8:45a.m. Sightseeing tour of Ishigaki begins.
TAMATORIZAKI OBSERVATORY PLATFORM, the scenic point is quite known, for the view of the East China Sea and Pacific Ocean on the other side can be seen from the vintage point.
YONEKO-YAKI, pottery produces the most colorful and possibly the most cute shisa statues in Okinawa. The workshop is just across the road from Yonehara Beach on the northern coastline of Ishigaki.
THE RYUKYU PEARL CENTER, at Kabira Bay is Japan’s only source of cultured black pearls. In Japan, the culturing of black pearls are performed only in Kabira Bay of Ishigaki Island & Funaki Bay of Iriomote Island.
KABIRA BAY, is said to be the most beautiful spot on Ishigaki Island. The beauty of green, small islands lying in the emerald green sea, the region is undoubtedly one of a kind.

Lunch at the POZA Oba-San no Shokutaku Diner, we will be having Ishigaki Beef Hamburger plate with Yaeyama Soba.

TOUJIN BAKA (CHINESE GRAVE), in 1852, 400 laborers being shipped to California, who were supposed to work as mine workers for the Americans & British traders. Chinese rebelled against the cruel treatment they received from the British. The ship however became shipwrecked off the coast of Ishigaki and 380 Chinese unboarded. Many of them were killed by gunfire from the British pursuers, died by illness or committed suicide. Ishigaki islanders protected and provided shelter for them and furnished them with food. In 1971 a Toujin (Chinese) grave was made in the memory of the 128 people who perished in this foreign land.

MINEYA, Yaeyama Minsaori, its origins are said to have come from India. It is also said that the term for cotton girdle, “Mensa” transformed to become “Minsa”. The Minsa was a special gift presented by young women to men as a sign of the acceptance of love. The combination of 5 (itsu) and 4 (yo) checker patterns characterize this fabric, the women’s confession of love: “Love me forever” (ikuyo...itsuyo).

Before going to the hotel, you will have some shopping time at ‘DAISO’ 100 Yen Store, Max Value Supermarket, Book Store “Kyouhan”, Drug Store “Eleven”, Home Center & etc.

- 4:45p.m. We will check-in at the ART HOTEL ISHIGAKIJIMA (formerly Nikko Yaeyama) for 1 night stay.
Highlight at the Art Hotel Ishigakijima for relaxation try their open bath, “NIFAIYU”(onsen style furo).
Open daily from 4:30-11:00p.m. and 6:00-9:00a.m.
- 6:00p.m. Buffet dinner with the group at Restaurant Aquarius on the 1st floor lobby at the hotel.
- 8:00p.m. “SHIMAUTA LIVE” Live Okinawan Music performed by local performer at the 1st floor near the lobby for about 30 minutes. (L, D)

Friday, Jan 22nd Ishigaki – Iriomote Island – Ishigaki – Naha

This is because 90% of the island is densely forested, and home to a huge array of wildlife, including the very rare Iriomote wild cat, a critically endangered species of cat, which can only be found on Iriomote.

11:15a.m.

Arrive at Iriomote Ohara Port. Transfer to Mihara to Yubu Island.

Access to Yubu Island by way of carriage drawn by water buffalo, which gently wades through the shallow water. Yubu Island comprises a sub-tropical garden, containing over 100 types of tree and a butterfly garden. Upon arrival at Yubu Island, some time to walk around.

12:30p.m.

Makunouchi Bento for lunch.

2:30p.m.

Upon arrival, we will take a cruise further inland on the Nakama River through the beautiful jungle and mangrove trees.

4:00p.m.

Depart Ohara Port for Ishigaki Port.

4:45p.m.

Arrive Ishigaki Port, please use the restroom before getting on the bus.

5:00p.m.

Depart on a chartered bus to Ishigaki Airport.
