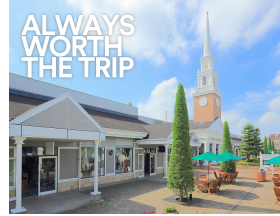

- 1:30-2:30p.m. Arrive SANO TOURIST FARM, Tochigi is Japan's largest producer of strawberries. Experience to pick sweet fresh strawberries for 40 minutes.
- 5:00p.m. Arrive at DAIWA ROYNET HOTEL UTSUNOMIYA for 2 nights stay, 8-10 minutes walk to the East Exit of the JR Utsunomiya Train Station. 'PASEO', train station shopping complex offering 3 floors of shops, restaurants, and fast foods. For dinner, you might want to try the famous Utsunomiya Gyoza "Minmin", "Gyozakan", or "Umaiya". Tsukiji's famous "Sushizanmai", Kamakura Pasta, Marugame Udon, & etc. Take-out foods are on the 1st Floor: Yakitori, Gindaco known for their "Takoyaki", & Supermarket. After check-in, as a group, Nadine & Sasaki san will take you around the train station area. (B, L)

Arrive back at Daiwa Roynet Hotel Utsunomiya. The rest of the evening at your leisure.

Friday, Apr 12th

Utsunomiya – Ouchijuku – Niigata

6:00a.m.(starts)

Breakfast at ‘LAPIS” located on the 3rd Floor.

8:45a.m.

Check-out of the hotel.

9:00a.m.

Bus departs for NIIGATA with one stop at OUCHIJUKU. Ouchijuku is a former post town along the Tohoku region. Today, Ouchijuku has been restored to look as it did in the Edo Period with telephone and electricity wires buried. The unpaved main street is lined by thick thatched roof houses with variety of shops, restaurants and minshuku (small traditional Japanese inns).

12:00-2:00p.m.

Upon arrival at Ouchijuku, you will have around 2 hours to walk around and have lunch on your own. Soba noodles and grilled Japanese dango mochi on sticks are popular specialties.

Depart for NIIGATA, will take almost 4 hours with 2 restroom stops along the way.

6:00p.m.

Arrive in NIIGATA, check-in at HOTEL OKURA NIIGATA for 3 nights stay.

After check-in, the rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

Saturday, Apr 13th

Niigata City

6:30a.m.(starts)

Breakfast at the hotel.

9:30a.m.

After breakfast, our first stop will be NIIGATA SENBEI KINGDOM, this facility was opened in 2002. Senbei are crackers made from rice, production volume of senbei in Niigata Prefecture is the largest in Japan. You can learn about the making of senbei and history of that sweet. Apart from viewing the process of senbei-making, you can also experience making senbei by yourself and then eating it.

11:00a.m.-1:00p.m.

NIIGATA FURUSATO MURA a large facility that introduces the local product of Niigata like sake, rice, senbei, and other specialty products.

Lunch on your own at Niigata Furusato Mura’s second floor, Food Court, Sushi Restaurant, and Soba.

1:45-2:45p.m.

After lunch, TSUBAME SANJO REGIONAL INDUSTRIAL PROMOTION CENTER for products created by artisans with traditional skills. You can shop for kitchen knives, silverwares, nail & nose clippers, saws, and kitchen tools.

2:50-4:15p.m.

5 minutes walk to TSUBAME AEON MALL, some leisure shopping time. There’s a supermarket and Baskins Robbins Ice Cream (1st floor) and 100 Yen Shop(2nd floor). (B)

5:15p.m.

Return back to Hotel Okura Niigata. Upon arrival, the rest of the evening at your leisure.

Sunday, Apr 14th

Niigata – Sado Island – Niigata

6:30a.m.(starts)

Breakfast at the hotel.

7:15a.m.

Transfer to Niigata Port for a 1 day tour of SADO ISLAND. Upon arrival, board the jetfoil to Sado Island.

7:45a.m.

Take the jetfoil (1 hour ride) to arrive at Ryotsu Port.

SADO HISTORY MUSEUM exhibits the cultural history of Sado Island , where robots relate the history and legends of Sado Island from 800 years ago. Robots made to exactly resemble the historical figures on Sado talk and dance.

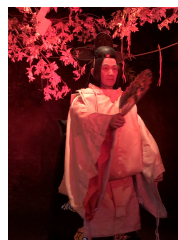

You will have the opportunity to ride the “TARAIBUNE (boat shaped like tubs)” in a small pool. Tarai Bune were first created, early in the Meiji period (1868-1912). Tarai Bune were used because they were more stable than boats in rocky waters and had sharp maneuverability. The boats are mainly used to fish turban shell, abalone and seaweed.

SADO NISHIMIKAWA GOLD PARK, a hands-on museum built on the site of the former Nishimikawa Gold Mine. The museum presents a variety of materials relating to gold and gold mining in its exhibition rooms and theater. Visitors can try panning for gold and participants can take home the gold dust they find stored in a keychain or pendant.

4:30p.m. Return back to Ryotsu Port, after check-in, you will have some time to do last minute shopping of Sado.
5:00p.m. Board the Jetfoil back to Niigata Port.
6:00p.m. Arrive back to Hotel Okura Niigata, the rest of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Continue on to MATSUMOTO CITY,
The drive will take about 4 hours with restroom stops and a lunch break at one of the Service Areas.

9:30a.m. Bus departs for MATSUMOTO CASTLE is one of five castles designated as ‘National Treasures of Japan’ and the oldest five-tiered, six-story castle tower remaining in Japan.
11:30a.m. Bus departs for ISHII MISO FACTORY founded in 1868 (the end of the Edo era) and is still producing miso by unique traditional and natural method. Miso is fermented food so it is very healthy.
Nagano Prefecture in Matsumoto is the top producer of miso (46%) in Japan.
12:30p.m. Lunch at Ishii Miso Factory.

3:30p.m. Arrive at TOBIRA ONSEN – MYOJINKAN (luxury 4 star hotel) for 1 night stay.
The hotel is nestled within a deep valley and surrounded by the mountains of the Yatsugatake National Park. The narrow, winding road to Myojinkan passing rice paddies, vegetable fields, and gives way to the verdant tree covered mountains of one of Japan's most beautiful protected forests.
After check-in, you can walk around the forest area or go to the lounge and have non alcoholic drink, hot coffee, or hot tea.
6:00p.m. Japanese dinner with Beef nigiri at the hotel.
After dinner, relax and try out the spacious hot springs (with open-air baths). (B, L, D)

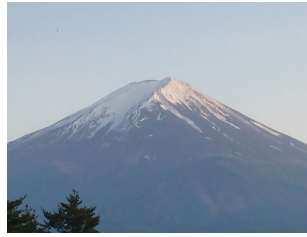
Wednesday, Apr 17th **Tobira Onsen – Yamanashi – Fuji Yoshida**

9:20a.m. Check-out of the hotel.
9:30a.m. Bus departs for Fuji Yoshida in Yamanashi with 1 stop at Fuji Motosuko Resort.
It will take about 2.5 hours to Yamanashi with restroom stops and a lunch break.

- 12:30-2:30p.m. Arrive at MT. FUJI SHIBAZAKURA FESTIVAL, one of the most popular occasions nationwide to see shibazakura (pink moss or phlox moss in English) with the background of magnificent Mt. Fuji. You will also get to enjoy local delicacies of the Mount Fuji area. Fujinomiya Yakisoba is stir-fried noodle mixed with meat, cabbage and bonito flakes to create a hearty and sumptuous meal. Mt. Fuji Delicious Foods Festival will be held in the park's restaurant and shop area, with stalls featuring delicious treats from different places around the mountain.

- 10:10a.m. Arrive at OSHINO HAKKAI, a small village with 8 springs of Mt. Fuji. The name was given to 8 ponds filled with melted snow water that has taken more than 800 years to filter through the underground layer of Mt. Fuji. The water of Oshino Hakkai is ranked among the best quality water of Japan. So bring a empty water container if you want to fill it up with Mt. Fuji water. Depart for HAKONE, upon arrival, we will take PIRATE BOAT CRUISE on Lake Ashi, enjoy the serene natural beauty of the crater. You can see the picturesque sight of Hakone such as the glimmering surface of Lake Ashi, the highest mountain in Japan, Mt. Fuji, and the red tori (gate) floating above the lake all at one glance. Arrive at Togendai, we will take the HAKONE ROPEWAY to OWAKUDANI. It is the perfect place for enjoying Hakone's scenic view. On a clear day, majestic Mount Fuji is visible, and the steam rising from the volcanic "Jigokudani" at Owakudani down below gives the trip an added thrill. Some shopping time in Owakudani, "Kuro-tamago (black egg)", which is said to increase your life by seven years if you eat one, a specialty item that can only be purchased here in Owakudani.
 3:30p.m. Bus departs for TOKYO with 1 stop at DANGOZAKA SERVICE AREA for 5-4-4.
 4:45p.m. Arrive at DANGOZAKA SERVICE AREA for 5-4-4 and some shopping time.
 6:30p.m. Check-in at HOTEL GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA for 3 nights stay in Odaiba. The hotel is located in Odaiba (an artificial island in Tokyo Bay) overlooking the Rainbow Bridge and across from Aqua City (shopping mall). The rest of the day at your leisure. (B)
 For dinner you can go to Aqua City: The 1st floor has a FOOD COURT, on the 5th floor there's a SIZZLER'S with all you can eat salad bar, and on the 6th floor is KAITEN SUSHI " TOKYO SUSHI by ITAME SUSHI", RED LOBSTER, TGI FRIDAYS, & etc.

Aqua City - most shops close at 9:00pm, restaurants at 11:00pm

Friday, Apr 20th**Tokyo City Tour**

- 7:00a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.
- 9:30a.m. Enjoy a full day of TOKYO CITY's SHOPPING.
- 10:00-12:00p.m. First stop, TSUKIJI OUTER MARKET, Japan's "FOOD TOWN" where one can encounter all kinds of Japanese traditional foods. A mixture of wholesale and retail shops along the numerous restaurants. Nadine & Sasaki san will take you to TSUKIJI UOGASHI, where there is clean restroom and food court. If you don't want to eat sushi then you can try Nadine's favorite "PORK SHOGAYAKI (pork sautéed) or PORK TONKATSU (pork cutlet).
Lunch on your own at Tsukiji.
SUGAMO, "Senior Citizen Harajuku" this shopping street is lined by over 200 shops that sell clothing, traditional food and other goods marketed toward the elderly. Among the most popular items is the district's signature red underwear, which comes in a variety of styles and is thought to bring luck. Some shopping time at UENO'S AMEYOKKO, a busy market street along the Yamanote Train Line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno stations.
Our first stop shop will be to MARUYASU STORE, cheapest place to buy individually wrapped scallops. MARUYASU STORE also has TIRAMISU CHOCOLATES, SOFT DRIED IKA & TAKO.
Maruyasu does have some things to sample like the smoked scallops, smoked Tako, & etc.
KASHI no NIKI maybe one of Ameyoko's most famous vendors. They have been in business since 1947, a large discount shop for rice crackers, sweets and candies.
