Be sure to ask the aquarium staff for a re-entry stamp before you leave the aquarium.

Dolphin Show (1:00p.m.) at Okichan theatre, which is a few minutes by foot from the aquarium.

Lunch at your own expense. Near the aquarium is the oceanview restaurant "INOH" which serves buffet style Okinawan Food with asst. dessert & drinks included (1520yen per person or senior citizen 65yrs old or over is 1190yen per person).

Or try "OCEAN BLUE CAFE" located on the 1st floor of the aquarium near the window of the Kuroshio Tank, serving Spaghetti Napolitano, Taco Rice, Taco Sandwich & drinks. There is also a snack bar located in the "Park Center" near the Okichan Theater & Dolphin Lagoon serving Okinawan Soba, Curry Rice, Taco Rice, American Dog & more.

Last stop, will be to KOURI ISLAND, part of Nakajin Village. Kouri Island and Yagaji Island are connected with a bridge (2020 meters long or 1.4 miles long).
