9:00a.m. Please meet your local bilingual tour escort, NADINE SHIMABUKURO, at the Japan Airlines check-in area at DANIEL INOUE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, Lobby #5. She will give you your packet with your JAL "E Ticket Receipt" and luggage tags prior to check-in. Due to tight airport security, you will be checking in individually or as a family. **Please have your passport ready.**
After check-in, you may want to head straight to the TSA line.

12:15p.m. Depart Honolulu on Japan Airlines Flt.#073 bound for TOKYO/ HANEDA.

A meal will be served one hour after take-off.

Mar 29th, Monday TOKYO/ HANEDA - FUKUOKA

3:55p.m. Arrival into Tokyo Haneda International Airport. Visit Japan Web (recommended) is a web service that people entering to Japan even Japanese citizens returning back to Japan use this for Immigration and Customs procedures in order to enter/return to Japan.

After immigration & custom, you need to go to the "electronic Japan Custom machine".

For your convenience, please use the baggage cart for your luggage.

Please pickup your own baggage from the carousel and go thru the electronic custom line.

After exit, please turn to your right to the far end of the building. There's an "Interline Check-in Counter" for Japan Airlines to check your luggage for our next domestic flight to Fukuoka Airport.

After we are done checking our luggage at JAL Interline Counter, we will take an elevator to the ground floor, and take the INTER-TERMINAL free shuttle bus to DOMESTIC TERMINAL #1.

Upon arrival at domestic terminal #1, we need to take the escalator to the 2nd floor (Departure Lobby).

7:25p.m. Depart Tokyo/ Haneda on Japan Airlines Flt.#335 bound for FUKUOKA DOMESTIC AIRPORT.

9:30p.m. Arrive FUKUOKA DOMESTIC AIRPORT.

Please pickup your own luggage(s) from the carousel in the baggage claim area.

For your convenience, please use the baggage cart for your luggage.

At the arrival lobby, you will be met by your English speaking tour guide from Tokyo, Ms Akiko Sasaki.

We will walk over to our chartered bus.

We will be staying 3 nights at THE ROYAL PARK HOTEL FUKUOKA, walking distance to Hakata JR Station also known as JR Hakata City. Within the Hakata Station, there is a supermarket, Tokyu Hands, and a lot of places to eat. Next to Hakata Station is the Hakata Bus Terminal which has 100 Yen Daiso, 300 Yen Shop, and many of places to eat.

First stop, ITOSHIMA's MEOTO IWA (Married Couple Rocks) sacred rocks located at SAKURAI

Hamburger Steak & etc. Next to the Bus Terminal is Sogo Department Store, on the 10th Floor has 15 different Restaurants (closes at 10pm), B1 Floor has bakery & sweets, and B2 Floor has bento to go (closes at 8pm). Kamiyacho Shareo, underground shopping mall is connected to our hotel, making it highly convenient. After check-in, the rest of the day is at your leisure. (B , L)

Apr 2nd, Friday HIROSHIMA - MIYAJIMA - HIROSHIMA

6:30- 8:45a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today 1 day tour of MIYAJIMA ISLAND.

We will take a short ferry ride to Miyajima Island. Upon arrival, walking tour of Miyajima.

Hands on experience to make your own MOMIJI MANJU (maple leaf bean buns) have been Miyajima's most famous confectionary for over 100 years and one of Hiroshima's famous products.

Experience the entire process from cooking the shell to filling it, under the guidance of an instructor.



ITSUKUSHIMA SHRINE on Miyajima Island is famously known for the "floating" torii gate. The shrine and its torii gate are unique for being built over the water, seemingly floating in the sea during high tide. Some free time for lunch and shopping at your own expense.

After the tour of Miyajima, take the ferry back to Hiroshima Port.

Return back to Rihga Royal Hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

Apr 3rd, Saturday HIROSHIMA (Half day Tour)

6:30- 8:15a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today we will go HIROSHIMA PEACE PARK and PEACE MEMORIAL MUSEUM.



PEACE MEMORIAL MUSEUM inside the park consists of two buildings. The museum with the history of Hiroshima and the event of the nuclear bomb. Its main focus is on the events of August 6, the dropping of the bomb and the outcome in human suffering.

GENBAKU DOME (A BOMB DOME) is the only structure left standing in the area where the first atomic bomb exploded on August 6, 1945.

THE CHILDREN'S PEACE MONUMENT located in the heart of the Peace Memorial Park. It is a symbol of Peace and hope. Erected in 1958, this monument pays a tribute to Sadako Sasaki, who died of leukemia ten years after the atomic bombing and to all the children affected by this tragedy.

After the tour of the park, we will walk to HONDORI SHOPPING ARCADE, where the locals shop and eat.

Arrive back to Rihga Royal Hotel. Free leisure time. (B)

Bus departs for NAGASHIMA ONSEN with one stop at AEON MALL ODAKA for lunch and shopping.

Arrive at HOTEL NAGASHIMA for 3 nights stay with beds, onsen in the hotel facility.

After check-in, enjoy some free time to rest or go to onsen before dinner.

Apr 5th Monday NAGASHIMA ONSEN - TOBA - NAGASHIMA ONSEN

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today we will go to TOBA CITY (MIE) to see the AMA (Marine women), how they dive and grilled some fresh seafoods in front of us.

AMA, literally called “Marine women” have handed down their free diving traditions through generations and lived in Toba and its neighboring areas for at least 2,000 year. Ama dive consecutively for around 1.5 hours Every morning, harvesting seasonal shellfish in depths of up to 20 meters(65.6 feet).

Enjoy freshly grilled seafood lunch prepared by the actual Ama divers in Osata, home to Japan’s largest active Ama population.

MIKIMOTO PEARL ISLAND is a museum about pearls, pearl cultivation and Mikimoto Kokichi, the pioneer who first succeeded in cultivating pearls. In the adjacent Pearl Plaza, you can view and purchase a wide variety of pearl jewelry.

11:00-12:30p.m. AEON MALL TOBA for lunch on your own and some shopping time. Restaurants on the 1st Floor & WATTS (100 Yen Store) on the 2nd Floor.
1:30-2:30p.m. KASHIKOJIMA ESPANA CRUISE, enjoy touring the floating pearl rafts and deep blue waters of Ago Bay.
4:00-4:45p.m. Strawberry picking at NAGASHIMA FARM for 40 minutes.
5:00-7:30p.m. NABANA no SATO to see tulips and special night illumination.

6:15p.m. Arrive NAGOYA CHUBU CENTRAIR AIRPORT.
Upon arrival, please have your passports & “E” ticket ready. You will then check-in, individually or as a family at JAPAN AIRLINES on the 3rd Floor, Counter G.
After check-in, you will have free time to have do last minute shopping.
Go through security and passport control to go to your designated gate for your departure flight.
After passport control, duty free and gift shops for your shopping convenience.
9:30p.m. Depart on JAPAN AIRLINES FLT.#798 bound for HONOLULU, HAWAII.
A meal will be served 1 hour after take-off.
10:00a.m. Arrive Honolulu, on the same day we departed, Wednesday, April 7th in the morning.
