Yanai Shirakabe Street is a stretch of road about 200 meters long in Yanai City. Both sides of the street are lined with traditional merchant homes that date all the way back to the Edo period, and in 1984 the street was above as an Important Traditional Building Programtion Area.

SAGAWA SHOYU BREWERY & MUSEUM by Sagawa Shoyu Soy Sauce Brewery, established in 1830. Part of the storehouse where Yanai's specialty Kanro Soy Sauce is kept has been opened to the public as a museum. Kanro Soy Sauce is a Sai-Shikomi (referented) soy sauce made by adding malted rice to already finished soy sauce and allowing it to ferment again. Inside the museum you can watch the production process of Kanro Soy Sauce brewed in the cedar tubs, and various tools used to make soy sauce.

Lunch on your own expense at YANAI FOOD HALL.

After lunch, shopping time at YUME TOWN YANAI, local supermarket and clothing store.

2:42p.m. A short ride on HELLO KITTY SHINKANSEN "KODAMA 849" bound for SHIN YAMAGUCHI STATION.

3:40p.m. Return back to HOTEL MATSUMASA, some leisure time to walk around the town area.

In the Yuda Onsen Tourist Center, there's "Kitsune no Ashiato" 200Yen per person for Ashiyu Fee. There's 3 different Ashiyu: Outdoor, Indoor, and Ashiyu inside a Café to enjoy desserts and drinks.

Or enjoy a quiet time in the onsen, open from 3pm-midnight.

Dinner is on your own. Inside the hotel property is TENKAIPPIN RAMEN, if you like ramen & gyoza. (B)

## Saturday, Oct 25<sup>th</sup> Yuda Onsen – Tsuwano (Shimane) – Yuda Onsen

7:00a.m. Breakfast at the hotel.

10:30a.m. Walk to YUDA ONSEN STATION (about 12-15 minutes walk).

We will pass out BENTO BOX to be eaten on the train.

11:10a.m. Board on to SL YAMAGUCHI GO bound for TSUWANO, SHIMANE PREFECTURE.

Steam locomotive train is a special train operated by JR West Japan.

1:10p.m. Arrive at TSUWANO STATION.

Upon arrival at Tsuwano, walking tour of the town and visiting TSUWANO JAPAN HERITAGE MUSEUM and walk around TSUWANO's HONMACHI DORI (Street). The town features several Preserved historic buildings and retains an atmosphere reminiscent of the past centuries.







4:12p.m. Board on to SL YAMAGUCHI GO bound for YUDA ONSEN.

5:12p.m. Arrive back to YUDA ONSEN STATION and upon arrival, walk to the hotel.

AKIYOSHIDAI KARST ROAD, Japan's largest karst plateau. It was designated as a National Monument (Akiyoshidai Quasi-National Park) in 1955 and a special natural monument in 1964.

The limestone that makes up the magnificent landscape of Akiyoshidai is about 350 million years ago in the southern sea. It was born as a coral reef, and over the years has formed a karst plateau like today.
