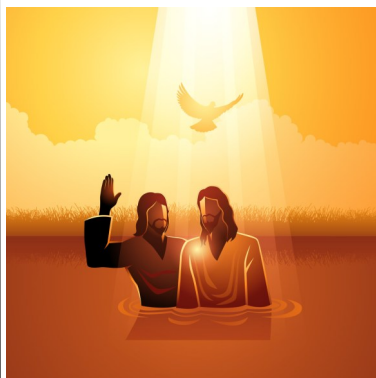
MASS ON THURSDAY 15

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD



Last September a Premiership footballer celebrated his team's 3-0 win over local rivals. He said it was the greatest day of his life. But in fact he had said this in advance of the day, because it was the day that he and his fiancée were to be baptised into the Christian faith. I wonder if you know who the footballer was!

Pope Francis reminded us a few years ago that we should make sure we know the date of our own baptism and celebrate it because it is the greatest day of our own lives. At the start of 2026, we look to the year ahead and celebrate the Baptism of the Lord.

Jesus was baptised at the age of about 30 and his baptism was the launching of his mission and his moving forward in the power of the Holy Spirit. The Gospel account tells us about the descent of the Holy Spirit like a dove, and the voice of God the Father affirming his Son.

The disciples were sent out to baptise in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. At our baptism, we were baptised in the name of the three persons of the Trinity, we were set free from original sin, and we were commissioned to preach the Gospel in our words and in our actions.

Just as married couples sometimes renew their marriage vows, and priests renew the promises they made at ordination each year, it is good for us to remember and renew the call of our own baptism and to give thanks for the gift of our own faith. Jesus was sent out after his baptism and we too are sent on our own missions.

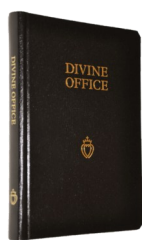
ADVICE AS ENERGY BILLS RISE

Bài đọc I: Is 42:1-4, 6-7

Đức Chúa phán: **“Đây là người tôi trung Ta nâng đỡ, là người Ta tuyển chọn và quý mến. Ta cho Thần Khí Ta ngự trên Người; Người sẽ làm sáng tỏ công lý trước muôn dân. Bài đọc II: Cv 10:34-38

Trong những ngày ấy, Phêrô lên tiếng nói: **“Quả thật, tôi nhận thấy Thiên Chúa không thiên vị ai; nhưng hề ai kính sợ Người và thực thi điều công chính, dù thuộc bất cứ dân tộc nào, cũng đều được Người đón nhận. Anh em biết: Thiên Chúa đã sai lời Người đến với con cái Israel, loan báo Tin Mừng bình an nhờ Đức Giêsu Kitô —Người là Chúa của mọi người. Tin Mừng: Mt 3:13-17

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

FIRST READING: ISAIAH 42:1-4, 6-7

Thus says the LORD: Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations. He will not cry aloud or lift up his voice, or make it heard in the street; a bruised reed he will not break, and a faintly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice. He will not grow faint or be discouraged till he has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands wait for his law.

‘I am the LORD; I have called you in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes that are blind, to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon, from the prison those who sit in darkness.’

In those days: Peter opened his mouth and said: ‘Truly I understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is

right is acceptable to him. As for the word that he sent to Israel, preaching good news of peace through Jesus Christ — he is Lord of all — you yourselves know what happened throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee after the baptism that John proclaimed: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.’
