"BEHOLD, THE DAY IS COMING..."

Next Sunday is the Feast of Christ the King and is the last Sunday of the Church year. The new Church year begins a

week later, with the First Sunday of Advent. So, the readings at this particular time make much reference to the "end times" and the Day of Judgement. In recent years I have noticed that in some city centres, you can still find people walking the streets with placards round their necks reading, "The end is nigh."



Today's first reading from the prophet Malachi begins, "Behold, the day is coming, burning like an oven, when all the arrogant and all the evil-doers will be stubble." Advent is a season of penance and preparation, like Lent, and shares the colour purple with it. We might be looking forward to Christmas, but it is good also to think about the ultimate direction of our lives and where we are with the Lord right now.

In the Gospel reading, Jesus also predicts a great day of reckoning that is to come. In particular he speaks about the destruction of the Temple. This had happened calamitously in Jewish history and in fact happened again about 40 years after Jesus' death and Resurrection, in 70 A.D. in a war between the Jews and Romans.

In the homily, I shall be speaking about these things as well as some incidents in my own life from the last few weeks which have really brought home to me how we need to face up to our own mortality. But I also want to stress the hopefulness of both the readings: the prophet Malachi assures the righteous that, "...the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its wings," and Jesus promises those who keep faith, "...your endurance will gain your lives."

Anh chị em thân mến: Các anh chị em biết chúng tôi phải sống thế nào khi ở với các anh chị em; vì khi ở với các anh chị em, chúng tôi không lười biếng, cũng không ăn của ai mà không trả công; nhưng bằng lao động và mồ hôi, chúng tôi làm việc ngày đêm để không trở thành gánh nặng cho bất kỳ ai trong các anh chị em. Không phải vì chúng tôi không có quyền đó, nhưng để làm gương cho các anh chị em noi theo. GOSPEL: LUKE 21:5-19

At that time: While some were speaking of the Temple, how it was adorned with noble stones and offerings, Jesus said, 'As for these things that you see, the days will come when there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down.' And they asked him, 'Teacher, when will these things be, and what will be the sign when these things are about to take place?' And he said,

'See that you are not led astray. For many will come in my name, saying, "I am he!" and, "The time is at hand!" Do not go after them. And when you hear of wars and tumults, do not be terrified, for these things must first take place, but the end will not be at once.'

You will be delivered up even by parents and brothers and sisters, and relatives and friends, and some of you they will put to death. You will be hated by all for my name's sake. But not a hair of your head will perish. By your endurance you will gain your lives.'
