



No cost private well sampling for Greenvale, Waterford, Sciota, Randolph, Castle Rock, Eureka, and Northfield in 2026 through the Community Focused Sampling Program

What is the Community Focused Sampling Program?

- Provides private well owners with free well water testing
- Testing is offered to different regions on a rotating basis
- Water is tested for common contaminants based on Minnesota Department of Health recommendations
- Since 2019, nearly 2,300 Dakota County well owners have participated

What happens after I send back my test kit?

- You will receive your results along with treatment recommendations (if needed)
- Acting based on your results is optional
- Data is reported only at the community level; your personal data remains confidential.
