

Are cremations done individually? When after death can a cremation take place?

All cremations in Massachusetts are done individually. We have always used fully licensed Massachusetts Crematories. In Massachusetts, there is a 48 hour waiting period before cremation.

What forms of payment do you accept?

We accept insurance, all major credit cards, checks, cash, Massachusetts state assistance, and Veteran services benefits. We review with you every possible and available benefit.

Can I pre-plan and pre-pay for a simple direct cremation?

Definitely, all you need to do is contact us. The cost of the cremation is guaranteed and will not change. The cost of your cremation is protected from inflation. Once you complete the \$2,495 arrangements, there are no additional charges.
