HOA Inspections

This month we will pay particular attention to yard maintenance. Let's keep our community looking good.

RULES IN REVIEW

Residents will make reasonable efforts to remove fallen leaf matter in their yard during/after the autumn leaf drop. Residents whose plants drop organic litter (leaves, fruit, seed pods, needles, etc.) onto their neighbor's Lot are responsible for either (1) pruning the plants so the litter does not drop onto the neighbor's Lot, (2) removing the organic litter from the neighbor's Lot, (3) coming to an agreement with the affected neighbor about who will remove the litter and maintain that agreement.

No billboard or sign shall be displayed upon any Lot, except that a Lot owner can place a "For Sale" or "For Rent" sign not larger than two (2) feet by three (3) feet on his Lot. Rule 6.15

A Rainbow Canyon resident must accompany their guests at all times while using the pool house. Do not let individuals who are not in your party into the pool house, even if you know them. Those entering without a key card will be considered trespassing.
