Parents/Guardians and Children will attend the Family Faith Formation sessions at Assumption Parish's Berst Hall. You may choose the Sunday morning session that runs from 9:45 a.m. until 11:15 a.m. or the Wednesday evening session that runs from 6:15 p.m. until 7:45 p.m. When you register your children for Religious Education, please choose the session that best fits your family schedule. The tuition is \$150 for one student or \$250 for two or more students.

During these Family Faith Formation Sessions, your children will meet with their own grade level catechist(s). The parents/guardians will attend a session with me to discuss topics intended to help them prepare for the teaching they will do with their children during the remainder of that month. Each month will highlight a certain theme or topic about our faith. Your children will be learning about the same topic at their appropriate grade level with you as their guide. The goal is to complete one chapter of the month's theme at the Family Faith Formation Session with the volunteer catechists, and then two additional chapters will be completed at home with the parents before returning to the next monthly Family Faith Formation Session. It is most important that both the students and the parents attend each of the monthly sessions.

Students will receive their books on the first day of classes. These books will go home with them in order to complete, with their parents, the three chapters assigned each month. All Chapter Quizzes and Unit Tests should be completed in the books. These books then need to come with them to each session at Berst Hall so that their work can be reviewed and so they can continue to work with their catechist on new chapters.

Please note that the second sessions in February and March have topics not specifically covered in the student textbooks. These sessions do not include homework assignments but instead are designed to help the parents and students develop a deeper understanding of the Sacraments which Christ has given us and that help us to grow in grace.

I am looking forward to a wonderful year of Family Faith Formation. I am deeply indebted to all our catechists, parents, and students who work so hard to grow in our Catholic faith.



# Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun.

When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"

Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; hypomone in Greek). Strive! Endure! Keep going! The one absolutely necessary virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey. The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!
