



You will notice that we are skipping over the book of Acts for Sunday preaching as we move on through the Bible Year Study. This is not to slight Acts, but rather an acknowledgement that we are being pressed for time to complete the New Testament by the end of the Church Liturgical Year. Also, please recall that Acts was written by Luke, who was addressed on September 21st. We are now shifting our focus to the books known as Epistles, or letters. We begin with the first canonical letter, which is Paul's letter to the church in Rome, also known as Romans.

As you read Romans, it is essential to know that this letter was the last one written by Paul, not the first. Much like the Old Testament, the NT, at times, orders books (or letters) from the longest to the shortest, rather than chronologically. This means Romans represents Paul's most well-developed theological thought. Most of Paul's writings are occasional, meaning they were written to address specific concerns in specific congregations. This is not true for Romans. For starters, Paul did not found this church and has little to no personal connection to them. The Wesley Study Bible states that: "Romans is widely regarded as Paul's most carefully considered, rhetorically sophisticated, and theologically important writing, composed near the end of his ministry and containing his mature reflections on the Christian faith." For all these reasons, Romans has been one of, if not the most, influential writings outside of the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. For our time together this Sunday, we will be considering the entirety of Romans Chapter 12.

I look forward to continuing this conversation with you all this Sunday.


Where's the Plastic Playground Border Around the Community Garden?
