



What kind of culture would have a lion's den and a great fiery furnace as means of capital punishment? Evidently, in Babylon under the rule of Nebuchadnezzar, these are the two means of executing an enemy of the state in the book of Daniel. With a setting during the time of the Babylonian captivity, Daniel tells stories of the Hebrew people remaining faithful to the God of Israel even in the face of death. In chapter 3, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego are sentenced to death for their refusal to bow down to a massive golden statue. Later on in chapter 6, Daniel is thrown into the lion's den for praying to YHWH despite a law that outlawed this act and made such praying punishable by death. In both cases, God delivers and rewards faithfulness.

This week, we will be studying the Book of Daniel in general and concentrating on the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego specifically (<u>Daniel 3:19-26</u>). While Daniel can feel foreign to us now, the struggle to remain faithful in a culture that has contrasting values is always a worthwhile discussion for followers of Jesus. I look forward to seeing you all this Sunday.




