This Sunday, we will discuss Isaiah, Judah, and those times long in the past, but come prepared also to explore what being told, "It's not me, it's you," means for our connection to God in the here and now.



Ladies of all ages are invited to come to the Sisterhood Getaway at Lutherock Camp and Conference Center, September 12th-14th! The


