



DUMC has experienced minimal staff turnover over the past several years, so it can be jarring to say goodbye to two pivotal members of our team in such a short period. Jennifer Ingalls has concluded her time at the church as of today (July 31, 2025), and Ben Nobles will bid us farewell at the end of August. Both have served crucial ministry roles in Children and Youth, and we are grateful for the contributions each has made to the life of the church and community. Please remember to be a blessing to Jennifer and her family by contributing to the love offering that is open through August 15. More information will be forthcoming on how we plan to be a blessing to Ben and his family as we approach his departure date.

As we bid farewell to what has been and look ahead to what is next for Children and Youth ministries, I would like to share the plan for moving forward, as developed by me and the Church Council. As you know, Cortni Rose is a gift to this church and has served as our Director of Communication for the past five years, where she has excelled in overhauling our website and digital/video footprint. What those new to our church may not know is that Cortni served as our K-5 Children's Director from 2016 to 2020, before moving into the communication role during the COVID pandemic. Cortni's ability to adapt, learn, and develop teams kept us afloat as we navigated lockdowns and curtailed in-person ministry. Cortni has graciously agreed to step into the interim role of guiding both Children and Youth, beginning this Sunday. Parents, please be assured that your children will be safe, well cared for, and provided with Christian formation, just as they have always been. Cortni has also served as a youth counselor alongside Ben and other volunteers for the past three years and knows the youth and the culture Ben established over the past five years. That culture will continue under her leadership.

To help Cortni be successful, additional changes are being made to cover the work she previously did and to support her in this new role. Beth Bynum will transition from part-time to full-time to assume several aspects of communication, and Billy Rose will expand his responsibilities by overseeing the livestreaming of services and events. We will hire additional part-time assistants for the children's ministry, who are TBD.

The recent feedback from our Church Chat indicates that this church has a deep desire to offer the best Children and Youth Ministries in our community. To accomplish this goal, we need you to be committed to supporting the effort through your giving. For some, that will mean giving monetarily; for others, it will mean giving beyond money, by also giving of your time. Please surround our youth and children with your prayers as we have committed to doing so. Prayer and support are more than pleasant thoughts; they are a sacred duty that we have vowed to undertake. Together, we can and will accomplish this God-given mission!

This week in worship, we encounter the Prophet Ezekiel amid Babylonian exile, finding himself caught up in a jarring vision from God. For a quick and easily accessed tutorial on the book of Ezekiel, follow these links to *The Bible Project* (Book of Ezekiel Summary, Part 1; and Book of Ezekiel Summary, Part 2). The text of Ezekiel chapter 37 shows the prophet in a valley that is full of bones, specifically dry bones, and asked the question, "Mortal, can these bones live?" How would you answer this question from the Lord? This Sunday, we will explore what these dry bones mean and how, ultimately, God is the one who answers the question of whether they can live again.

Some other things are happening on Sunday in worship, such as my sister-in-law, Kristie Autrey, Principal of Mitchell Elementary School near Spruce Pine, NC, sharing how DUMC has partnered with her school to help kids impacted by Hurricane Helene improve reading outcomes. My mother will also be attending, and I am looking forward to having her and my brother, Chris, as guests. Additionally, we are commissioning a short-term international mission team to Trinidad at the 11:00 a.m. service. Finally, communion will be served at both services, as is our practice on the first Sunday of each month.


Bridges Ministry Update




