

THIS WEEK IN WORSHIP

Last week's service at the Rock Springs Campground was fantastic. Thank you for coming out and worshipping with your fellow United Methodists in eastern Lincoln County. This Sunday, we return to worship at Denver with services at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. We also step back into our journey of reading/preaching through the Bible in one year. Once again, we are in the book of Psalms, particularly [Psalm 118](#).

Psalm 118 is referenced in all four Gospels, the book of Acts, and 1 Peter, making it one of the New Testament's most quoted Old Testament scriptures. Do these words sound familiar: *"The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone"* Psalm 118:22 (NRSV)? Or, *"Blessed is the name of the one who comes in the name of the Lord,"* Psalm 118:26a (NRSV)?

Both of these verses express something unique about the character of God. For one, God is often portrayed as a builder: *"Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain"* Psalm 127:1, *"See, I am laying in Zion a foundation stone, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation: 'One who trusts will not panic.'"* Isaiah 28:6. Why is this important? Because God is the creator and is constantly at work interacting with creation. He is the builder who never stops working on the project he loves. As a key part of the project, we are constantly being shaped and re-shaped by the God who does not give up on us. Furthermore, we are promised that when we represent God back to creation, God will hold us in favor. Psalm 118 has multiple images and meanings for our journey with God - I hope you will join me this Sunday as we dig deeper into God's Word and explore the Bible together.






