



This Sunday: Ordinary People, Extraordinary Grace

The people we meet in Scripture can sometimes feel worlds apart from us. They lived thousands of years ago, spoke different languages, and experienced life in ways that seem far removed from our modern world. Figures like Abraham, Moses, King David, the apostles, and St. Paul often fall into the category of "heroes of the faith."

But how do we relate to heroes—especially ones who seem so distant from our everyday reality? When we feel that distance, it's easy to slip into the mindset: "Who am I to do something great for God?" Yet that's not the message Scripture wants us to take away.

The stories of our faith remind us that these men and women were ordinary people—imperfect, fully human, just like us. And this Sunday, we'll take a closer look at two of these "ordinary heroes," Paul and Peter, as they find themselves in a very human moment of tension.

In <u>Galatians 2:11-14</u>, we see these two saints struggle with one another. Yet even in their disagreement, God is at work, using their interaction to reveal a more profound truth—a story of grace, growth, and calling that continues to include us today.

Join us this Sunday as we explore how God uses ordinary people to tell an extraordinary story.

If you would like to donate candy, host a trunk, or submit a soup or chili to the cook-off, please email Cortni!






Mentors Needed at Rock Springs Elementary School


