This is a crucial question that everyone who has encountered Jesus is responsible for: Who is Jesus to you? This question is at the heart of this week's message. 




Meet Us at The Hub


Author Book Signing – Supporting the Children's Backpack Program, Sunday, September 28th


We offer age-appropriate Sunday School classes for Preschool, K-3 rd and 4th-5th at our 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. services.
