The text was not from my phone number; it was from a bot, no doubt working out a scam. Not long afterwards, another church member let me know that she had also received a scamming text. Ugh... I will never ask for your help with a financial situation via text or email, so be on guard for this type of fraudulent activity. This situation is one of many data points that make me feel like the world is not as it should be, and the world is obviously broken. When good people get hurt and taken advantage of, I get mad. How about you? I want to do something about it, act on my anger, and carry out justice as I see fit. How about you?

Then I open the Bible, and hear the voice of Jesus teaching love for enemies along with " ...do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you" (Luke 6:27-28 NRSV). Honestly, if I could have these scamers in front of me, I doubt I would propose a prayer meeting, which is why I cannot be trusted with my own judgment and must give myself over to Jesus' greater wisdom.

This Sunday, we are asked to sit at Jesus' feet as he teaches us his ways and values. I admit this is not the best way to fill a church building. Promises of retribution and holy wrath on others, that'll bring people in. More MMA and less reconciliation is a better marketing plan. But Jesus does not have a marketing plan; he simply has the truth of God. Are we willing to listen?

If we have the stomach for it, read <u>Luke 6:27-49</u> in preparation.


## Author Book Signing – Supporting the Children's Backpack Program, Sunday, September 28<sup>th</sup>
