



Scripture for Sunday: John 18:1-11

Next up in our journey through the Bible is the Gospel of John. One quickly notices that John is different from Matthew, Mark, and Luke, as John does not start with a narrative but with a theological prologue, establishing the pre-existence of Jesus alongside God the Father as the creator of all things. This is cosmic power that calls all of existence into being. That power, according to John, is fully vested in the person of Jesus. Reading through John's Gospel, one sees that Jesus is never at a loss but always entirely in control. The late Dr. Mickey Efird taught students at Duke Divinity School to see Jesus in John's Gospel as the producer, director, and lead actor of the show. Personally, I need to be reminded that the power of God Almighty is in Jesus, especially in times of turmoil. Jesus is more powerful than chaos, political division, economic uncertainty, violence, war, famine, hate, and all that would stand in the way of God's good plan for creation. This Sunday, I hope you will join me as we celebrate the strength of our Savior, who is indeed mighty to save.


New Bible Study for the Fall!

Church Council Updates

Your Church Council took the following actions at its August meeting:

- Approved installation of 12 security cameras at entry points on campus
- Approved closing the MOPS restricted fund (\$2K) and moving it to Children's Ministry
- Heard a report that new Sanctuary lighting will be installed in early November
- Approved funds be moved from the hurricane relief fund to Mitchell Elementary School (\$3K)
- Received a report from Trustees on repairs to facilities, July-August. Major items:
 - HVAC in CORC \$9,942
 - HVAC Cedar Street \$6,067
 - HVAC Scout Hut \$325
 - Mulching property, van repairs, ballfield well pressure tank, and equipment - \$6,000
