The "Our Lady of Mercy White Scapular" is a devotion connected to the Order of Our Lady of Mercy, also known as the Mercedarian Order, which was founded by St. Peter Nolasco to free Christian captives. It focuses on the themes of acquiring salvation, freedom from evil, and receiving God's mercy. The scapular is white, featuring a symbol on the front such as a gold "A" and blue "M" (for Ave Maria), and on the back, a symbol of the Mercedarian Order or Our Lady of Mercy.

The scapular is a symbol of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, particularly associated with the Mercedarian Order. The scapular is worn as a reminder of devotion and a sign of consecration to the Virgin Mary. It symbolizes an internal commitment to faith and prayer, rather than being just an external sign.

The confraternity associated with this scapular received indulgences approved in 1868 and renewed after the Second Vatican Council in 1967. Wearing the scapular serves as a constant reminder to have recourse to Mary for graces and protection.

For members of the Confraternity of Our Lady of Mercy, a plenary indulgence can be obtained on the following occasions, provided the specific conditions are met:

**Day of enrollment:** On the day a person is formally invested in the confraternity and receives the scapular.

Mercedarian feast days: On the feasts of various Mercedarian saints and the feast of Our Lady of Mercy:

May 6

August 31

December 6

At the hour of death: A plenary indulgence can be obtained at the point of death, provided the person is properly disposed and has been in the habit of reciting some prayers.

- 8) The White Scapular is in honor of Our Lady's Perpetual Virginity.

9) Through wearing the White Scapular, hope to be covered in the purity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
