## BAWBURGH GOLF CLUB - MEN'S SECTION RULES FOR THE GEORGE FULLEGAR TEXAS SCRAMBLE 2022

- 1. The Competition will be played on a date to be determined by the Men's Section Committee. If the Competition has to be abandoned or cancelled due to weather conditions, it shall be rearranged or cancelled completely in accordance with the Men's Section Bad Weather Policy.
- 2. The Rules of Golf, plus any Bawburgh Golf Club Local Rules at the time of the Competition, will apply.
- 3. The Competition will be open to <u>all</u> members of Bawburgh Golf Club, except for juniors aged 10 or under, with an official WHS Handicap Index on the day of the Competition, but only those who have played in at least <u>8</u> <u>handicap qualifying competitions</u> during the 12 months prior to the Competition will be entitled to win the Competition.
- 4. The Competition will take the form of an 18-hole Texas Scramble (medal scoring) played from the yellow tees by <u>all</u> players.
  - The England Golf Maximum Score guidance will not apply for this Competition.
- 5. The WHS Handicap Index limit for the Competition will be 36.0. Players with a higher Handicap Index may still enter but will be required to use a Handicap Index of 36.0.
  - Lady members will receive 5 courtesy shots, added to their Course Handicap before calculation of the team handicap.
  - 4-person teams will be allocated a combined handicap (to the nearest decimal point) calculated upon 25% / 20% / 15% / 10% (from lowest to highest) of their Course Handicaps on the day of the Competition.
  - 3-person teams will be allocated a combined handicap (to the nearest decimal point) calculated upon 30% / 20% / 10% (from lowest to highest) of their Course Handicaps on the day of the Competition.
- 6. Players may enter their name on the booking system for the Competition, once it becomes available, and may play at any tee-time available on the day of the Competition.
- 7. The entry fee, as specified by the Men's Section Committee, <u>must</u> be paid before playing in the Competition; if not paid, the player will not be entered in the Competition.
- 8. There will be no waiver of any additional green fee due payable by 5-day or non-peak members, nor will any concession be made to those who have a points membership by virtue of the fact that they need to use more points because of the time they are due to play.
- 9. Play in the Competition will be in teams of 3 or 4-balls, all starting from the first tee. Each player will be required to use a minimum of 4 tee-shots.
  - The player whose ball is chosen will play the next shot first, followed by the other players who must place and play their ball from within 12 inches of the ball that was chosen, or from the exact same place when on the green.
- 10. Players may use buggies during the Competition, subject to course conditions allowing.
- 11. In the event of a dispute regarding the rules during the Competition, a team may choose to complete a hole with two balls without penalty, in accordance with the Rules of Golf. The team should advise the Golf Office, at the end of the round, of any dispute as to the score and ask for a ruling. If the Golf Office is unable to make a ruling, then the Men's Section Captain and Vice-Captain will adjudicate, and their decision will be final. The team should submit their scorecard after a ruling by the Golf Office or pending a decision by the Men's Section Captain and Vice-Captain.
- 12. SCORECARDS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE GOLF OFFICE AT THE END OF THE ROUND VIA THE AGREED METHOD(S); FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
- 13. The winners of the George Fullegar Texas Scramble will be the team returning the lowest nett medal score over 18 holes. In the event of a tie, the winners and other prize places will be determined by the lowest nett medal score on count-back, being the last 9 holes, last 6, last 3 and last one and, if still tied, the last 6, last 3 and last hole on the front nine. If still tied, teams on the same score will share the trophy and prize vouchers.
- 14. Prize Vouchers will be awarded to the winners, runners-up and other places, as agreed and specified by the Men's Section Committee, based upon the number of entries.
