Psalm 23 is a very familiar Psalm by King David. Historians believe it was written around 1000 BC toward the end of David's life. He had seen God do some miraculous things in his life, but this verse in this passage stands out to me. Psalms 23:4 says, "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me." This verse is a good reminder that we are walking through the trial, not trapped in it. The greatest blessing is that we are never ALONE. He is with us every step. The rod represents His power, and the staff represents His guidance. To have a shadow, there must be a source of light behind it. Instead of looking at the circumstance, look for HIM in it, and He will see you through it.
