While on the water, the winds started to be contrary, and they were being tossed by the waves. In the darkest part of any night (fourth watch), Jesus went to them. When they first saw Him on the water, they were fearful as they thought it was a spirit. But Jesus spoke to them and said, "Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid." There are two things from this story that I love. First, no matter what circumstances we are in, Jesus is there in the midst with us. Secondly, I love how Peter wanted to get closer to the LORD in the storm. When we are in trials, our flesh wants to quit and pull away, but we should move in closer to the LORD and not run from HIM. I have little sticky notes on my desk at the office that say SEEK THE LORD or LEAN IN (meaning to lean in to what is hard and scary). I see these notes every day, and they remind me to pray and trust HIM with whatever the day holds.
