

1. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The inspector and workshop accept no liability whatsoever for any fault, defect, failure, damage, breakdown, loss, or issue that exists before, occurs during, or arises after the inspection, whether identified or not identified.

By proceeding with or relying on this inspection, all parties acknowledge and agree that:

- The inspection is advisory only
- No responsibility is accepted for future repairs, failures, or costs
- No responsibility is accepted for losses, inconvenience, disputes, or consequential damages
- The final decision to purchase or sell the vehicle is not the responsibility of the inspector or workshop

2. NO PREDICTION OF FUTURE CONDITION

A vehicle inspection cannot predict the future.

The inspector cannot and does not assess or guarantee:

- Future mechanical or electrical reliability
- Future engine, transmission, driveline, or electronic failures
- Long-term oil usage, oil leaks, or oil consumption
- Long-term coolant or water usage
- Overheating issues that occur over time or under extended use
- Wear-related or age-related failures

Components that appear acceptable at the time of inspection may fail without warning at any time.

3. VISUAL & NON-INTRUSIVE INSPECTION ONLY

This inspection is strictly visual and non-intrusive.

The inspector is not responsible for:

Any road test conducted is:

- Limited in distance and duration
- Conducted under normal driving conditions only

The inspection cannot replicate long-term use, towing, high-load driving, or extended operation.

7. ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC & COMPUTER SYSTEMS

Modern vehicles contain complex electronic systems. This inspection does not guarantee:

- Continued absence of warning lights or fault codes
- Future operation of electronic modules, sensors, or control units

Electronic failures may occur without warning.

- The inspection findings are independent, factual, and unbiased
- The workshop accepts no liability for any fault, failure, or issue at any time

Seller Conduct & Feedback Agreement

I further acknowledge and agree that:

- The inspection outcome may influence the buyer's decision not to proceed with the purchase
- The inspector and workshop have no control over the buyer's final decision

- I will not hold the inspector or workshop responsible if the buyer chooses not to purchase the vehicle

I agree that I will not engage in, encourage, or permit:

- Harassment, abuse, or threats toward the inspector or workshop
- Defamatory statements, false claims, or misleading representations
- Negative reviews, feedback, or public commentary arising solely from the buyer's decision not to proceed with the purchase

I acknowledge that the inspection is performed in good faith and that the inspector's role is not to support or undermine the sale, but to report observable conditions at the time of inspection.

11. BUYER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & ACCEPTANCE
