#### **CHURCH-RELATED SCHOLARSHIP:**

Undergraduate College/University

#### **Qualifications**

\*Committed to church-related vocation.

Applications will not be accepted without written description of your calling to a church-related vocation.

\*An active resident member of a SC Southern
Baptist Church for at least nine (9) months prior to
the beginning of an academic school year &
approved by action of the church where you are
an active member. Applications will not be
accepted without church recommendation.
\*Enrolled full-time in a SC college/university
accredited by the Southern Association of
Colleges and Schools.

- \*Agreement to participate in ministry-related practical experience of at least 3 hours per week under a designated supervisor.
- \*Classified as a full-time student who maintains a grade point average of "C" or its equivalent.
- \*Attendance at a personal interview.
- \*Ability to establish the need for financial aid.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP INFO:**

Financial assistance is determined by financial need.

Financial assistance is sent directly to the school to be applied to tuition and academic fees.

#### Richard Furman Scholarship:

Masters Level Seminary & Graduate School

#### **Qualifications:**

- \*A South Carolinian who is a member of a Southern Baptist Convention Church & attending one of the six Southern Baptist seminaries or one of the three SCBC universities.
- \*Applicants must be approved by their home church in SC.
- \*Applicant must be enrolled as a part-time or fulltime seminary or Christian ministry graduate student and maintain a grade point average of "C" or its equivalent.

#### **SCHOLARHIP INFO:**

\*Scholarships will be given only to students who are prepared to serve as members of ministerial staffs of churches cooperating with the Southern Baptist Convention or to serve on the boards, agencies or institutions of state Baptist Conventions or the Southern Baptist Convention.

\*Scholarships will be given only to students who need assistance in meeting the cost of their seminary or graduate school tuition and fees. This assistance is only for the fall and spring terms and not for short-term, "J" term or summer school. Students will only be eligible to receive the scholarship a maximum of three (3) years.

\*Scholarships are sent directly to the SBC seminary or SCRC university to be applied to tuition \$

or SCBC university to be applied to tuition & academic fees.

\*These scholarships are NOT available for doctoral level students.
