
## Thank You for your Support of Our Missions!

### Messengers to the Annual Meetings of OCBA shall be:

1. The pastor or interim pastor of a member church.
2. For the first \$500 or fraction thereof in undesignated offering given to OCBA, each church will receive three (3) Messengers (pastor plus two members).
3. One additional Messenger elected by the church for every additional \$500 in undesignated offering to OCBA after the first \$500 in undesignated offering.
4. The minimum number of Messengers per church shall be three Messengers (pastor plus two members).
5. The maximum number of Messengers per church shall be eleven Messengers (pastor plus ten members).
6. The Credentials/ Church Relations Director will receive any conflict concerning seating of Messengers.

### Article IX – of OCBA Bylaws:

1. Neglect of a church to send Messengers to Annual Meetings for 3 consecutive years.
2. Neglect of a church to submit the Annual Church Profile for two consecutive years.
3. Neglect of a church to financially support the Association for two consecutive years.
4. A gross doctrinal error as determined by the Association.
5. The Church Relations Director should seek reconciliation with the church before final dismissal.
