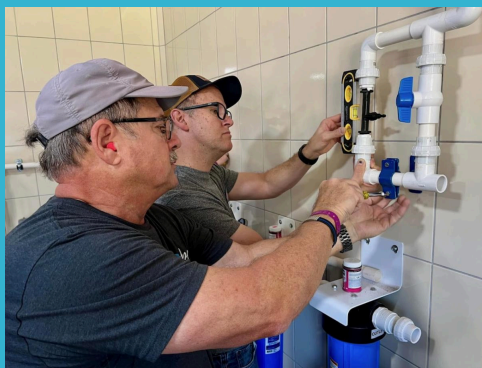




Spring 2025

We started the spring season off with an installation in Santiago, Atitlan, Guatemala. The week began with team members and church volunteers gathering to prepare materials for the nearly 500 anticipated students, followed by the health and hygiene training of church leaders. On the same day, the installation team began their work setting a new record for first day progress - the result of many willing helping hands between team members and church volunteers! Following health and hygiene lessons on



Tuesday with the students, the team and church hosted approximately 85 women from within the community for a time of evangelism, with the lesson topic being "The Samaritan Woman". Afterwards, the women were given the gift of a Spanish Gideons Bible, a donation generously coordinated by a March team member. By Wednesday, the installation team had completed the system and operator training was continuing on. The installation team joined the rest of the team for the final day of education with the students in the morning. It was a great morning that included a little dancing and lots of laughter by all. In the afternoon, the team distributed bags of food and bottled water from the newly installed system to 10 families in need within the community. On Thursday evening, the church held their dedication of the system and included messages from the Pastor, worship music and a ribbon cutting. A toast of purified water for all followed for the many blessings we all pray the system will bring to the community.

May brought LWWM to the Iglesia Evangélica Centroamericana Luz y Verdad in Aldea San José, San Francisco Zapotitlán, Guatemala. On Monday, each time got right to work, with the Education & Evangelism team training 18 church leaders in the Hygiene curriculum, followed by prep of the week's lesson supplies. The team then had over 200 children from the community attend an evangelism



activity where they sang songs and learned how God gives us a new heart. Day one of the system installation was a success. This location had received a system 10 year ago, providing many years of clean water. With much upgrading needed, it was decided a new system with new technology would be installed. By Wednesday, the E&E team had completed lessons with 370 children! Wednesday afternoon the entire team joined up along with church leaders to visit the homes of 10 elderly families, distributing groceries and supplies, 5-gallon bottles of purified water from the system along with words of hope and prayer. The system dedication ceremony on Thursday was a heartwarming celebration of the blessings this system will bring.

This spring we held our World Water Day Fundraiser. Board members came together collectively to match all donations made and together with our wonderful supporters, we raised \$16,200!

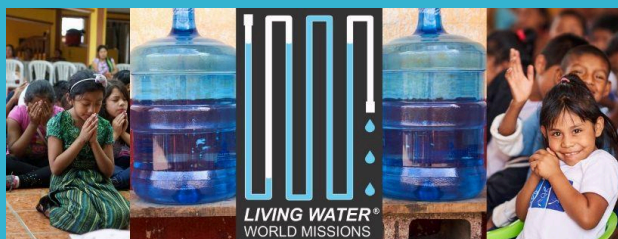
