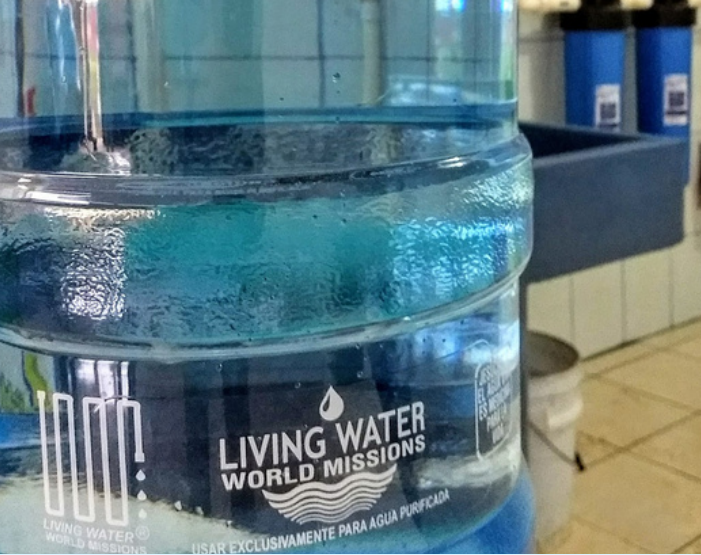

# 1. INSTALL

LWWM teams install clean water filtration systems with in-country partners within three days. The systems produce up to 300 gallons of clean drinking water per hour, enough to supply a community with clean water for a generation.

# 2. TEACH

Alongside the system installation, teams train leaders, families, and children health and hygiene education. The message of Jesus Christ as the Living Water is the priority in our teaching.

# 3. SHARE

All system operators, such as churches or schools, are responsible to share clean water with their communities. LWWM helps our partners find the best model that fits them to distribute clean water.
