LWWM had a full summer with installations in Pajapita, Guatemala, El Jícaro, El Progreso, Guatemala and Follow-up visits.

Our June installation was at the Iglesia Príncipe de Paz in Pajapita, San Marcos, Guatemala. The Education and Evangelism team did a fantastic job working together. By Tuesday, the group of children attending had grown from 11 to 42! On Wednesday the team hosted about 25 children who



participated in a fun afternoon of games and a thoughtful lesson inviting them to get to know Jesus better. By the end of the afternoon, three of the youth had raised their hands that they had received Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

The installation side of the team had a great week with much help from church volunteers. By Wednesday, the system was pressure tested and sanitized and bottle filling began! The team was able to join the church in delivering clean drinking water within the community, which included families in need and a local rehabilitation facility for disabled children and adults.



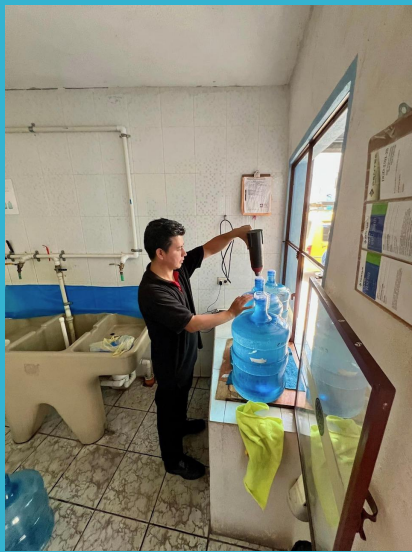
July brought board members to the areas of Sololá and Panajachel for eight follow-up visits. To see the sites doing so well is an absolute blessing. One of our oldest systems, which will be upgraded next year, currently produces 250 bottles a week that are given away to the local schools, police department and the poor. Other newer systems are making around 16,000 gallons of clean drinking water each month. A visit to LWWM's very first water system brought great joy and pride to the team to see them bottling 135 bottles a day. The system supports a full-time operator, two delivery drivers, and funds many outreach programs of the church. The team also had the opportunity to coordinate an Evangelism activity with local children on their last day of visits.



Our August team was in El Jícaro, El Progreso, Guatemala at the Iglesia de Dios Evangelio Completo, La Arenera. This trip kept the Education & Evangelism team very busy, as they had the pleasure of visiting two local



schools with almost 400 students all together! The team also had the honor of giving out 190 dresses once again to little girls at the school, thanks to Visalia nonprofit, Dress A Girl. These schools will benefit from the system, as the church will be donating water to them. A smooth installation of the system enabled the team to help fill the first 25 bottles that were then distributed into the local community. The week ended with a dedication of LWWM's 108th installation. A great evening of celebration that followed a great week of teamwork.

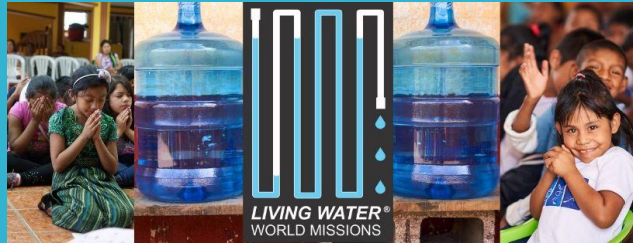
