4. Cloch Road Proposals

We have now received the Council's proposed plan to address the ferry traffic congestion and parking issues on Cloch Road. It involves creating a passing place and introducing a resident permit parking scheme on a six month trial basis. This agenda item is an opportunity for Cloch Road residents and all impacted by the proposals to have their say. The community council's submission to Inverclyde Council will reflect the majority of views and individual residents can write to the Council to share their thoughts.

5. Town to Town Calmac Ferry

We've been working with our Dunoon CC friends to ensure a more sustainable future for our town to town ferry service (Calmac). Unreliable sailings impacted passenger numbers and led to a reduced service. Cowal Transport Forum submitted an expression of interest for an asset transfer of terminals and a new operator and Dunoon CC are visiting to update us on the developments.
