

Ivorys Rock Pet Policy

Ivorys Rock is a pet-friendly venue. Guests acknowledge that pets may be present on site and accept all associated risks.

- A maximum of 2 dogs per campsite applies, with a 1:1 person-to-dog ratio. Additional dogs may be approved upon application.
- All pets must be approved at check-in and remain under the owner's control at all times.
- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. If pets are found off-lead, one warning will apply; on a second occasion, guests will be asked to leave.
- Pets must not be left unattended in the campground.
- Pets are not allowed in any common areas including camp kitchens, shelters, amenities or onsite accommodation.
- Pet owners are 100% responsible for picking up their pet's waste in a sealed plastic bag and disposing of it in the rubbish bins.
- Pets must not be washed or cleaned anywhere in the park, and pet items are not to be cleaned in campground facilities.
- Pets that are noisy, disruptive, or aggressive may result in the owner being asked to leave.
- Owners are personally responsible for any personal injuries, property damage, or losses caused by or related to their pets.
- Restricted and prohibited breeds: No regulated or prohibited dog breeds, as defined by Queensland Government legislation, are allowed on site. Guests must ensure their pets comply.
- By entering the property, guests confirm their pets are healthy, vaccinated, and free from disease.
