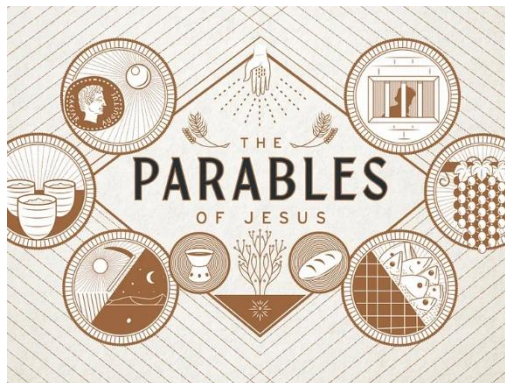
HELPING HANDS for September
