

Dear Badminton Participant,

Welcome to the 2021 Bay State Summer Games Badminton competition. It will be a great weekend of Badminton! The information on this sheet is specific to Badminton, so please read carefully.

### **LOCATION**

The Badminton competition will be held August 27-29 at Boston Badminton in Westborough, MA. The address is 169 Flanders Rd, Westborough, MA 01581

## **PARKING**

Park in Boston Badminton parking lot in marked spaces. Parking along Flanders Rd is acceptable, but please pull in completely off the road. <u>Park head in</u> on the Boston Badminton side in order to maximize spaces. DO NOT PARK ON THE SPACE RIGHT NEXT TO DRIVEWAY ENTRANCE; it blocks the driver's view when coming out of the Club to Flanders Rd. Overflow parking is available in the upper parking lot of KBQ Industries, 173 Flanders Rd, next door to Boston Badminton. Proceed down the driveway and park in the <u>lot on the right</u> at the bottom of the hill. Parking is allowed on the KBQ driveway on the Boston Badminton side, so long as cars <u>do not park</u> on the grass. Do not park in the driveway or parking lot of the Sikh Temple across Flanders Rd from the club or anywhere along that side of Flanders Rd.

## **SCHEDULE**

The schedule can be downloaded from our website at <u>www.baystategames.org/badminton</u>. When you click on the schedule link, then click on players, then your name to see the schedule of your first match for each event.

# **COVID PROTOVOLS**

Before attending the Badminton competition, all participants should review the following questions. If you answer YES to any of these questions, **DO NOT GO TO YOUR EVENT.** 

- 1. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 3 weeks?
- 2. Have you had close contact in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, been instructed by health provider to quarantine or had a COVID test but not received results yet?
- 3. Do you currently have any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new cough, or new loss of taste or smell?

Masks must be worn at all times when in the building, EXCEPT, when on the court playing in a match.

Participants must provide their own masks. Spares will be available if a mask is lost or damaged.

Athletes are asked to arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before the scheduled start of their division. Once an athlete loses two matches, they are asked to leave the building. Participants are asked to keep 6 feet of social distance between each other when not competing. No food should be brought to the venue except energy bars for personal consumption or equivalent. All participants must provide their own equipment and not share equipment with others Any acts of sportsmanship or team bonding should be in a touchless manner – no handshakes, fist bumps, high fives, etc. All participants must provide their own water or sports drinks and only drink from their own containers. Each participant should put their name on their water container. Boston Badminton has two cold water refill stations. CUPS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED. ATHLETES MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN WATER CONTAINER. NO SHARING OF WATER!

#### **CHECK-IN**

Check-In and Awards will take place outside, in a tent that will be set up at the entrance to the facility. Registration would only be moved inside in the event of heavy rain. As part of COVID protocols for the tournament, all participants are asked to check in NO EARLIER than 20 minutes before their scheduled start time. Please note that at check in, some athletes will have an additional payment due to adding a late event (doubles) or not paying the \$10 late fee if they registered after August 1. This will be marked on the registration sheet. Participants can pay via cash, Venmo or check (payable to Bay State Games) PLEASE NOTE THAT A 10 MINUTE DEFAULT TIME may be implemented for matches so be sure to be on time for your match.

#### **FOOD AVAILABILITY**

The availability of food at the Boston Badminton facility is very limited. Participants should bring what they feel they need for food and drink.

## **VERIFICATION OF LEVELS**

The Bay State Games Badminton Tournament Committee will review all levels indicated by participants on their entry form. The committee reserves the right to change a players' level after a review of their playing experience. The Bay State Games Badminton Committee has the final say regarding the level that each athlete participates at.

## **AWARDS**

The top three competitors in each division, will receive the appropriate Gold, Silver or Bronze Bay State Games medal. In all divisions, the top 4 finishers will receive Bay State Games sweatshirts. In the following divisions with more than 10 competitors (Junior 1 BS, Junior 2 BS, A MS, A MD and A XD) the top two competitors in the consolation round will also receive Bay State Games Sweatshirts. Athletes that win a medal in more than one event will only receive one sweatshirt.
