We are excited to kick off the season with the Central Oregon Soccer League (COSL) Jamboree! The jamboree is listed as your first game on your PlayMetrics schedule.

The COSL Jamboree is a fun, low-pressure event designed to introduce players to their teams, coaches, and the game environment. For many players, this may be their first experience with soccer or even a team sport—we hope this day serves as a positive and memorable introduction!

This day is all about learning and enjoyment. Scores are not kept, and the focus is on creating a positive first experience for all players.

Event Overview

Each team will participate in:

- A short practice session
- A scrimmage against a team of similar age

Teams will share a field (each using half), with approximately **45 minutes total field time**.

Event Purpose

The jamboree is designed to:

- Kick off the COSL season
 - Help players meet teammates and coaches
 - Provide time on official game fields
 - Build confidence and encourage fun experiences
 - Help new players learn the game and expectations

Format by Age Group

PreK – 1st Grade

- Half field per team
- 15–20 minute practice
- One 15-minute scrimmage

2nd Grade

- Half field per team
- 20–30 minute practice
- One 15-minute scrimmage

3rd – 8th Grade

- 20–25 minute practice
 - 20–25 minute scrimmage
 - Coaches will help monitor play (no assigned referees)

Field Locations

- 4v4, 5v5, 7v7: Skyliner Sports Park
- 9v9: Pacific Crest Sports Park

Each session includes a practice, scrimmage, and short halftime if needed.

Substitutions & Participation

- Unlimited substitutions allowed
 - Only registered COSL players may participate
 - Teams may be combined if short on players due to the holiday weekend

- Home Team: Black jerseys + game ball
 - Away Team: Grey jerseys
