

Commissioner Meeting Minutes  
March 25, 2026

Meeting called to order at 4:00 pm.  
All Board members present

The Board reviewed and signed Warrants

Mr. Bursch made a motion to approve the minutes of March 11th, 2026, seconded, all in favor.

The developer and engineering firm Haley & Ward, presented to the Board their draft plans for the development around 110 Burrage St. They wanted the residents to be informed about Article that will be presented on Saturday for the Annual meeting regarding expanding the District.

Agenda line item IV was passed over.

The Board reviewed Tighe & Bonds proposal for the submission of the application for the One Stop Growth grant. The Supt and Clerk felt this grant needed a lot more details and information than what they could provide, so they support this proposal. Mr. Bursch made a motion to approve the proposal from Tighe & Bond for \$4700.00 for the One Stop Growth Grant application. Second, all in favor.

The Supt got a call from DEP earlier today regarding the SRF program. Earlier this week residents had gone on a public meeting with DEP regarding the Districts approval to be placed on the Intended use Plan and receive SRF funding. Those residents, all of which were a part of the group, Lunenburg Citizens for Affordable Clean Water, tried to tell the DEP to pull the funding that we were approved for.

Mr. Woodward wanted to congratulate Mr. Esposito on his 29 years as Water Commissioner.

The Clerk explained that while the Water District uses Facebook as a social media tool to reach the residents regarding meetings or getting information out, it is not always monitored. When residents have questions or concerns about the post they need to reach out directly to the District's office or email for a response. If they don't feel they've gotten enough information, anyone can request to be put on the agenda for a Commissioners meeting.
