Commissioner Meeting Minutes September 10, 2025

Meeting called to order at 4:00 pm. All Board members present

The Board reviewed and signed Warrants

Mr. Bursch made a motion to approve the minutes of August 27th, 2025, Second, all in favor.

The Supt received a call from DEP last week and they told him they contacted Scott Horsley, the Woodland's water resource consultant to inform him that DEP had concluded that the Woodland's Condo Association will need to move their kayak rack, which is located in the Water District's Zone I. The Board agreed to wait until we receive the official letter from DEP before contacting the Woodland's attorney about setting a date to have the rack moved by.

The Rolling Acres water main project is moving right along. The Supt planned on pressure testing and chlorinated the new line next week, then all that was left was to tie in the residents' service lines and clean up all the areas that were disturbed.

The Supt will be meeting with Tighe & Bond tomorrow to further investigate the treatment option for the Keating's and Lancaster Ave wells to tie together. Resident William Emkey was invited to the meeting as he had questions regarding this option as well.

The Supt had gotten a quote from a hydrogeologist to look into additional wells located at the Keating's well site. The Board agreed to have the Supt hire him in order to provide a full quote on developing those wells.

DOT had responded to the final completion application for the Mass Ave water main project. They had requested that two driveways be looked at and one spot needed additional loam and seed. The Supt will follow up with DOT and the contractor MDR.

No public comment

Mr. Bursch made a motion to adjourn to Executive Session, not to return. Second, all in favor.
