May 27, 2026

Meeting called to order at 4:00 pm.

The Board discussed the presentation that the Supt had done from the night before.

The Supt updated the Board on the leaks that had been fixed over the past two weeks. The radio guys are continuing to work on updating the system.

Mr. Emkey requested when the sanitary survey comes out to please send him a copy.

Mr. Woodward requested the entire Board, the Supt and Clerk, to all be prepared to come up with a solution to the kayak dispute in the Zone I area of the Hickory Hills Well. He wants this topic to be placed on the agenda at the next meeting on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Recent photos show that residents have been violating the protected Zone I area. The Clerk will reach out to the legal firm representing the Woodland's Condo Association to invite them to attend as well if they would like to.

Mr. Emkey referenced the kayak rack affidavits he was given from the Woodland's residents. At a previous meeting the Commissioners informed him that the Water District was told they should communicate through the Woodland's lawyer. Mr. Emkey stated he did not feel that was fully expressed in an email the Clerk had given him. Mr. Emkey reviewed possible procedural changes that the Board could implement to try and make discussions more formal.
