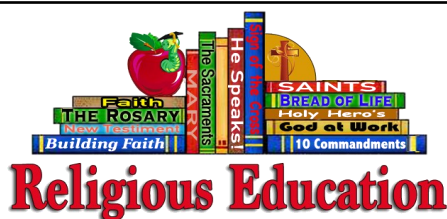

If you are over 18 you need to be registered on your own and no longer under your parents. To register call Sr. Angelina at 942-1616 or visit stmarkri.org/register.

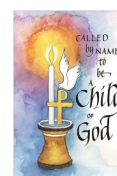


Questions on Baptizing your baby?
