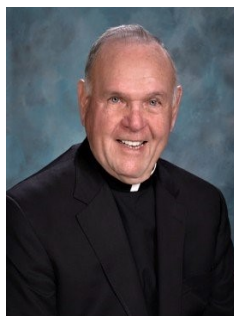


This Wednesday, we joyfully welcome our new Pastor, Reverend Timothy D. Reilly, to St. Mark Parish!

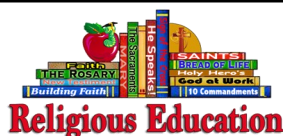
