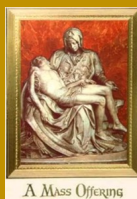

This year, we are pleased to welcome Deacon Wesley Lindsay from the Diocese of Jackson, Mississippi, who will be visiting our parish to share about the mission and needs of his diocese and to ask for your support. The Diocese of Jackson is the largest diocese east of the Mississippi River by geographic area and serves a Catholic population of approximately 50,000.

Nine counties currently have no resident priest.

Recently, the diocese received a request to assign a religious sister to serve one of these counties.

Unfortunately, the response had to be, "We're sorry, but there are not enough funds." As a result, another county remains without any Catholic presence.

With Catholics making up less than 3% of the population, your generosity can help make the Church present in communities that desperately need pastoral care and ministry. Mission Appeal donations also make it possible for more than 1,000 poor and underprivileged children to attend preschool and elementary school throughout the Diocese of Jackson. These programs also provide nutritious summer meals to hundreds of children and young people at the mission schools.

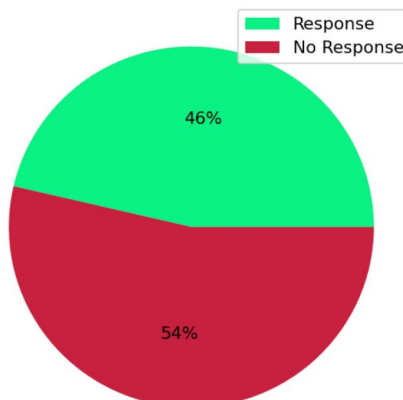

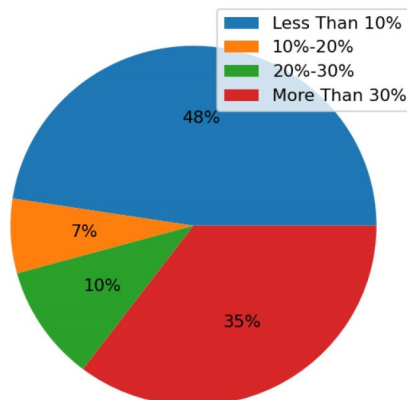

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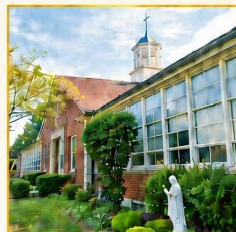
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
