Welcome Fr. Timothy Reilly!



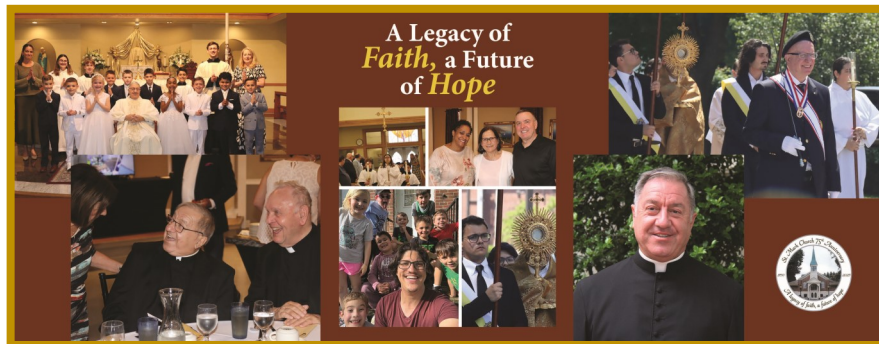
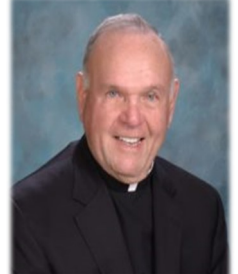

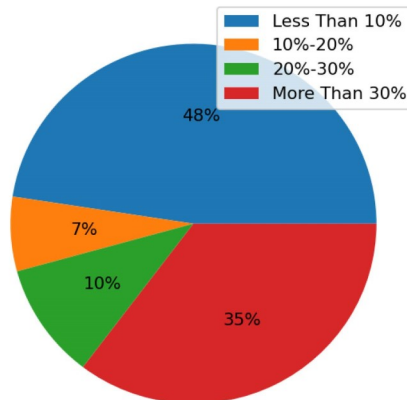
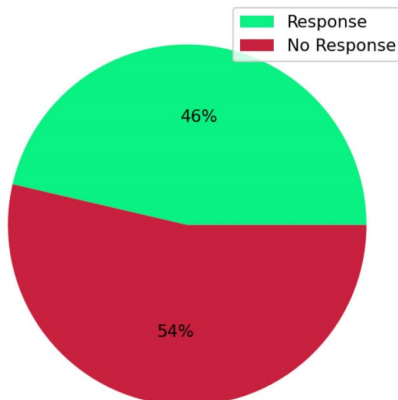

A 33% increase in giving from 269 respondents resulted in an additional \$68,607.10!

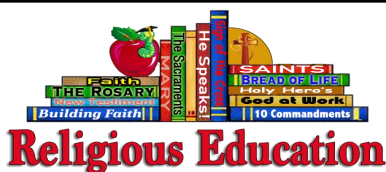
Response Rate
