sharers in her mission: “Baptism is the sacrament of

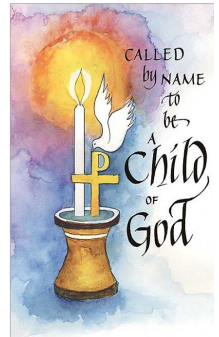
regeneration through water in the word.”

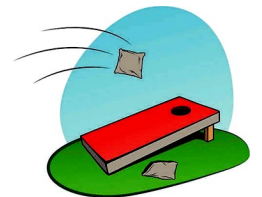
