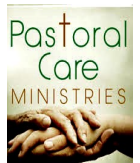

Baptism is one of the three sacraments of initiation:

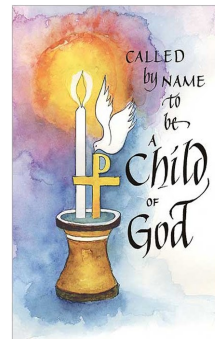
Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Summer is upon us and this means warmer temperatures.

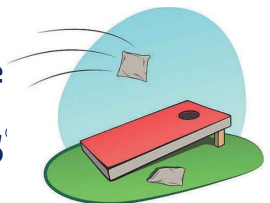
While attending Holy Mass we must remember that appropriate and modest dress is still required.
