After the walk Mike Gething (retired vet) will answer your questions and provide useful information on caring for your Labrador in his/her latter years.

You are invited back to the house afterwards for coffee/tea whilst your dogs can remain off lead in the confines of the dog proof section surrounding Mike and Pat's home.

Directions: Griggs Road is off the main Whitford Highway (on your right about 7.5 km from Botany Town Centre). After you turn into Griggs Road travel down the new road through the trees at the turnaround – approximately .5km from the main highway. Please Park on the road and walk through the pedestrian gate. Please keep your dogs on the lead until everyone has arrived.
