-  Required security fencing on all campuses
-  Circulation improvements between intermediate & primary
-  New or updated electrical infrastructure at high school
-  Internal safety improvements at junior high
-  New fire system at high school

2. Aging Infrastructure

-  HVAC replacement at primary & intermediate, improvements at junior high
-  New gym, locker rooms, & support spaces
-  Renovated band hall/choir
-  A/V & lighting upgrade at auditorium
-  Plumbing improvements at intermediate and high school
-  New & renovated academic spaces, special education facility, & CTE center

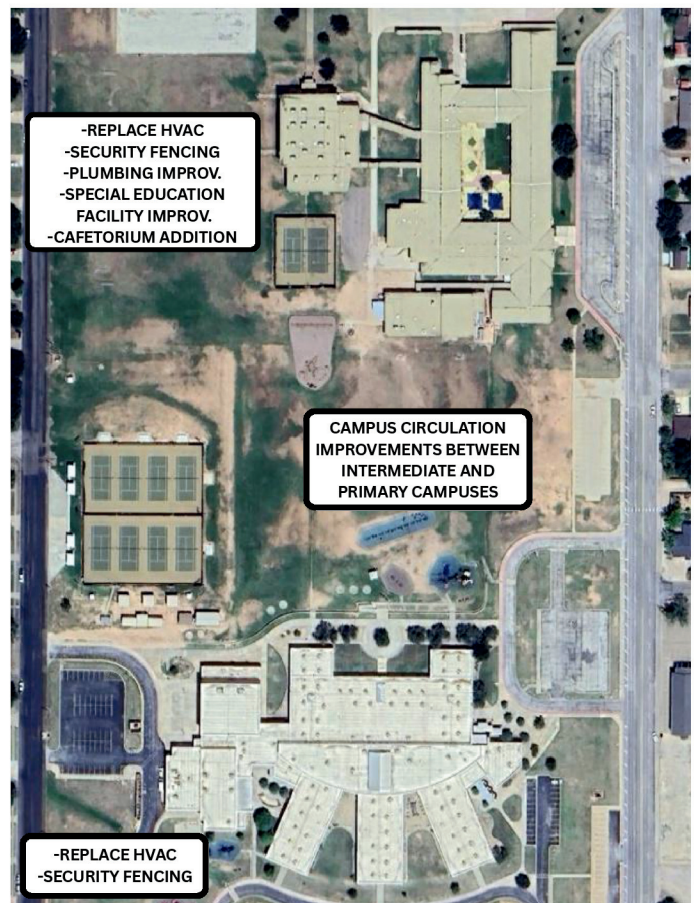

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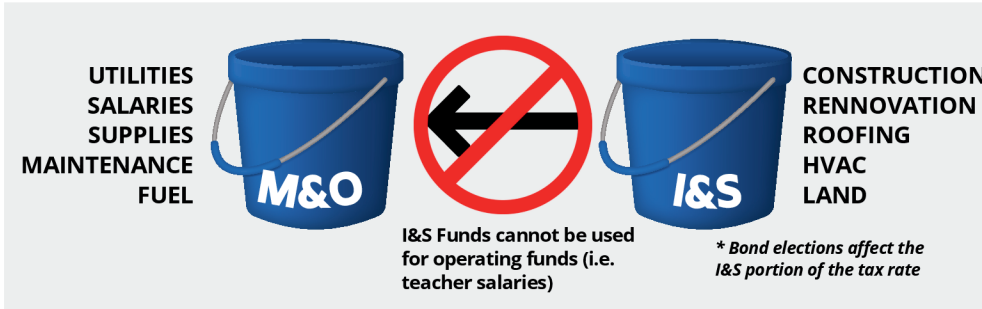

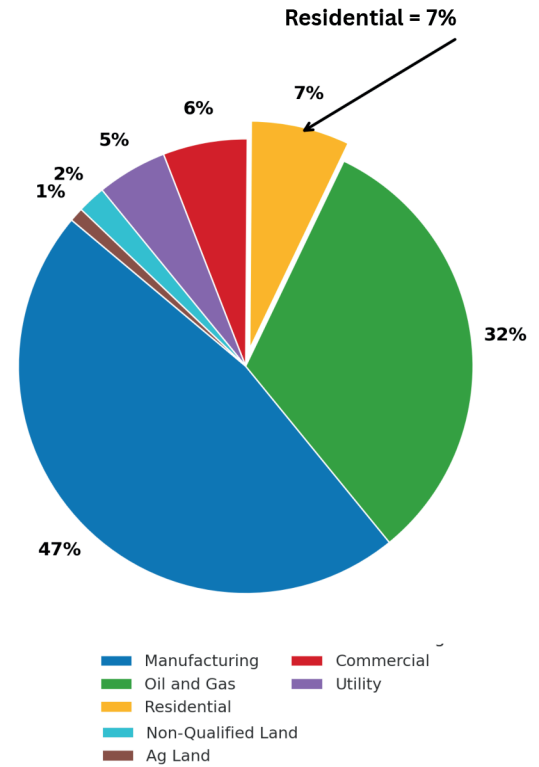

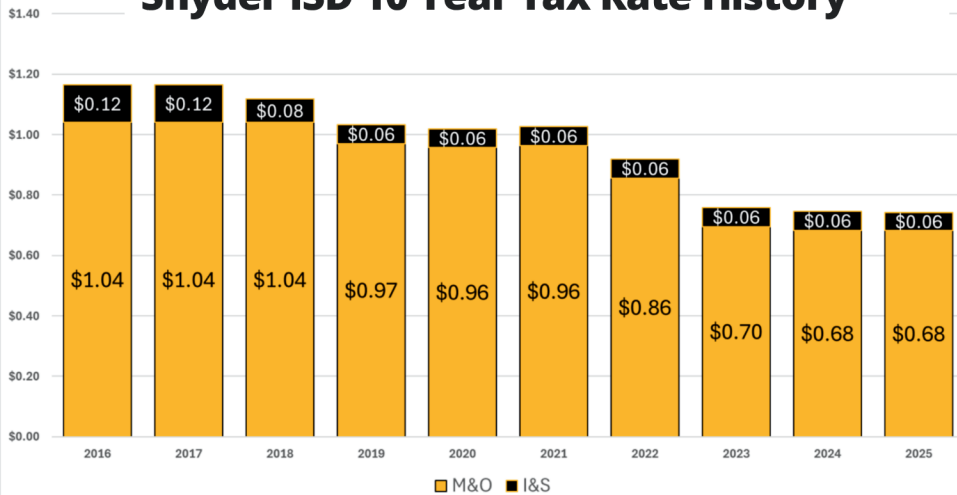
What makes up a school district's tax rate?

BOND BACKGROUND



In early 2025, Snyder ISD formed a Facilities Assessment Committee of more than 25 parents, staff, educators, business owners, civic leaders, and community members. The group met monthly to tour campuses, review building conditions, and discuss long-term needs, with a focus on safety and instructional effectiveness.

Based on the committee's findings, the Snyder ISD Board of Trustees unanimously voted to call a \$170.9 million bond election.

If approved by voters, the proposed bond is designed to:

- Improve safety and security across campuses
- Update aging facilities and infrastructure
- Expand accessibility and opportunities for all students
