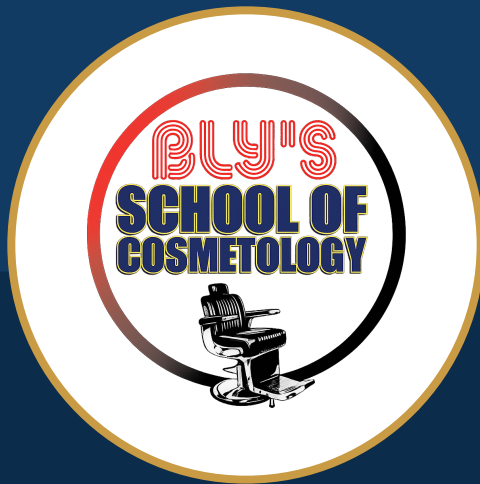

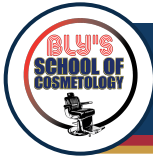

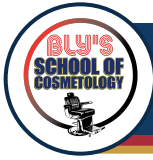

- Present valid identification.
- Provide an official transcript when requesting credit for previous hours.
- Review and sign the Enrollment Agreement.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Applicants should contact Admissions, complete an interview, submit the application and required documents, review program costs and schedules, sign the Enrollment Agreement, and pay the required deposit to secure a seat.
